TIMBERWOLVES FOOTBALL BOOSTER AT-A-GLANCE GUIDE

BACK THE PACK PEP RALLY

The evening before the first official practice of the season, the T-Wolf leadership chairs put on a pep-rally to get the school excited for the season and to introduce our football team to the students, families, and community. It's a great evening for both families and the student body with food trucks, music, and hometown high-school spirit!

BOOSTER MEETINGS

These meetings are for EVERYONE and held in the football locker room.. The only requirement to be a part of booster is to have a player in the program. Booster meetings are a way for all families to hear first-hand reports from Coach Jones about the program and learn what events are coming up. Each member present has a right to vote on any issues brought to the floor. These meetings are a way for families to get all questions answered in person.

CHAIN-GANG

NNHS is responsible for providing a chain-gang for all 9/JV & Varsity home games. The chain-gang consists of two volunteers to hold chains and one for the downs box. Varsity games also require a volunteer for the clip marker. This is a great way to have a bird's eye view of the game but does require the ability to move quickly, following the game up and down the field. As a bonus, the chain-gang gets free entry to the games they work.

COACH'S CARE COMMITTEE

The main function of the coach's care committee is to make sure coaches are fed dinner every Sunday evening while they watch film and prepare for the upcoming week. In addition, we like to make sure each coach feels loved on their birthday and for any special occasions that arise.

CORPORATE SPONSORS

END OF THE YEAR BANQUET (December)

The end of the year banquet is a large ceremony for ALL football players and families. This is when coaches recognize players from each class and special awards and recognitions will be presented.

Volunteer opportunities include set up and break down.

FAMILY DAY (August)

Our family day is in August after all teams have played their first intrasquad scrimmages. Each year we do something a little different with the goal of a fun, family event! This is an opportunity to bond and get to know teammates, coaches and families. Volunteer opportunities include food donations, food servers, and more!

FEED THE PACK (9/JV & VARSITY)

Volunteers are needed to help pick up or coordinate food prior to games. Freshman and JV are fed prior to all games. Varsity is fed only for travel games (travel is considered outside the metro). Also, for varsity games, a volunteer is needed AT the away game site to help coordinate picking up or collecting delivered food for the bus ride home.

FUNDRAISERS

Each player is expected to raise \$1000. Our fundraisers include:

- Telethon - May. Players gather during a practice to call families and friends for straight donations (\$500 each).
- Discount cards - August. Players sell cards with discounts from places around the community (\$500 each).

Families may opt to buy out of fundraisers in red. More information in our parent packet.

GAME DAY HELP

It takes a village to make game day a success!!! Freshman and JV game-day volunteer opportunities include merchandise sales at the gate and a chain gang.

Varsity game-day opportunities include chain gang, T-wolf tunnel, pre-game and half-time snack donations, program sales, merchandise sales and more. As a bonus, game-day volunteers get free entry to the game they work.

HOMECOMING

Homecoming is Friday, October 18, 2024. Thursday evening prior to the game, NNHS puts on a great community wide parade that runs north up Stubbeman and ends in the NNHS parking lot at a large carnival. Each football class will have their own float. Volunteers are needed to decorate floats and donate candy.

LIFT-A-THON

Lift-a-thon is a coach lead initiative each March. The goal is to emphasize the importance of our off-season workouts and to provide support for our football team expenses. The players will get donations per pound they lift (with a goal of \$150 each and is NOT a part of the buyout).

MOM'S HUDDLE

Prior to the season, moms (or mom-like guardians) and players will meet for a great night of fun and education. Coaches will explain the season and teach Football 101. Then, moms will go outside (dressed in her son's jersey) on the field with their player and position coaches to learn and practice their player's position. It's an evening full of bonding and fun (wear comfy clothes)!

NUTRITION CART

Each week, booster provides \$400 worth of healthy snacks for our players before and after practice. Volunteers are needed to pick up the order at Sam's on Sundays and deliver it to the field house.

PLAYER FEE

A \$100 fee per player is used to help off-set the many benefits each player gets from being in the NNHS football program. Fees are due **July 31, 2024**. If this is a financial issue for your family, please contact any booster board member or Coach Jones.

SENIOR NIGHT COMMITTEE (November)

Senior Night is Friday, November 8, 2024 and is held on the field, just prior to kick-off. This night is a special opportunity to recognize our senior players, filmers, managers and athletic trainers along with their families. Volunteer opportunities include the coordination of flowers, the balloon arch and the flow of the ceremony.

SHOPPES ON STUBBEMAN (August)

Shoppes on Stubbeman is held at NNHS in early August and is for parents and players to learn about different clubs and organizations. It is also the best way to load up on NNHS gear, sign up for clubs and PTO, pick up yearbooks, parking permits and meet some of the teachers and staff. Volunteer opportunities include merchandise sales.

SKORDLE

Skordle is a large all-day event held in June (at OSU this year - this is typically an event we host at NNHS and can't wait to host again in our NEW STADIUM). This is a 7 v 7 tournament for a select skills roster that is TBD.

SPIRIT COMMITTEE

The spirit committee decorates the locker room using the game-day themes and helps promote special events like Pink Out, Military Appreciation night, etc. Volunteer opportunities include making posters and fun spirit treats prior to game day, decorating locker rooms and helping with take down Tuesdays after the 9/JV games the night before.

SPOOKTACULAR (October)

Spooktacular is an evening community wide trick-or-treat event held by and at NNHS. Football sponsors a room and passes out candy to community kids. Volunteer opportunities include decorating, taking a shift with players, and candy donations.

SUNDAY COACHES MEALS

During the season, our coaches meet ALL DAY on Sunday to review film and prep for the upcoming week. To show our gratitude for their commitment to our program, we have families donate and deliver a dinner (super simple stuff) for them while they work (delivery is usually around 4:30pm).

T-WOLF TUNNEL (VARSITY GAMES)

The T-Wolf Tunnel is a limited committee of parents who transport, arrive early to assemble, then stay on the field to disassemble our CO2 light frame and T-Wolf tunnel for ALL varsity games. The tunnel is transported by our coaches. But the frame is a 100% volunteer effort and is used at all home and away games.

Hello Norman North Football Families!

It's hard to believe, but we are now less than 6 months away from kickoff of the first game of our 2024 season and the booster club is in full swing. Our 2024-2025 executive board was voted in on February 21, 2024. We have already been busy determining our budget, planning for spring meetings, determining volunteer needs and discussing fundraisers. We are pleased to report that in 2022, our booster club became a 501c3. This was a huge step for our program, and one we hope will help with our fundraising efforts moving forward. We are also excited to tell you, thanks to the passage of the 2023 school bond, we will be getting our own football stadium. Yes, you heard that right. After traveling to Harve Collins for the past 28 years, we will be getting our own Norman North football stadium.

It takes a tremendous amount of resources to run a 6A football program. Each year our goal is to raise \$150,000 through player fees, corporate sponsorships and fundraising.

Player Fee

Norman North Football has a \$100 player fee (due July 31, 2024). This is standard in most athletic groups at Norman North and is a small, but important part of our overall budget. Corporate Sponsorships

We hope to continue to grow our corporate sponsorship program. Our goal for this season is \$55,000.
