



Glen Ellyn Titans Holiday Tournament Rules

1. **Overall:** Two games (Girls) and Three games (Boys) guaranteed. Two referees, one scoreboard operator, and one scorekeeper will be provided for each game.
2. **Warm Up:** Teams will be allowed 5-10 minutes for warm up (time permitting). Games will start promptly at game times posted. If a team is unable to field five players at game time, the game will be a forfeit.
3. **Forfeit:** If a team is unable to field five players at game time, the game will be considered a forfeit. There is no refund for the attending team, but the game will be scored 15-0 in their favor.
4. **Game Time:** Four, 6-minute stop clock quarters. The clock stops for all whistles, injuries and timeouts. Half time intermission will be 5 minutes. A running clock will commence in the 4th quarter if a team gets up by 20 or more points.
5. **Time Outs:** 2 time outs per half plus 1 additional time out for each overtime. No time outs will be carried over from half to half or into overtime. Overtime periods will be 2 minutes of stop clock. After two overtimes the game will go to sudden death. The first team to score any type of point will win the game.
6. **Bonus:** Double bonus (2 shots) will be in effect on the 5th team foul of each quarter.
7. **Zero-tolerance Policy:** For coach, player, or fan will be in force. If a coach or player has been issued 2 technical fouls he/she will have to leave the building immediately and will not be allowed to coach or play any of the remaining games in the tournament. Fans will have to adhere to the no tolerance policy as well. If this policy is violated, the person will also be asked to leave the building immediately. His/her team will be issued a technical foul if they are in violation of the policy. It is the coaches' responsibility to control their players and fans.
8. **Uniforms:** Must be the same color for each team and have a number on the back. Away teams will be listed first on the schedule and ideally wear darker colored jerseys. Home teams will be listed second on the schedule and ideally wear white/lighter colored jerseys.
9. **Ball Size:** 27.5 for 4th/5th Girls; 28.5 for 6th/7th/8th Girls and 3rd/4th/5th Boys; 29.5 for 6th/7th/8th Boys.
10. **Pressing:**
 - 3rd-5th Grades- Man to Man only pressing allowed last 2 minutes of each half and overtime.
 - 6th-8th Grades- Man to Man or Zone pressing allowed all game and overtime.
 - No pressing allowed by any team once up by 15 or more points.
11. **Defense:** 3rd-5th Grades- Only man to man; 6th-8th Grades- Any defense allowed (man to man, zone, etc.)
12. On site Tournament Coordinator(s) have full authority of events on and off the playing court and final say.
13. You can only be rostered on one team unless otherwise approved by Tournament Coordinator.
14. Teams must supply their own warm up balls. Referees will approve game ball.
15. All teams will receive t-shirts for participating, but first place in each division will receive a "champions" t-shirt.
16. **Division Tie Breakers:** Will be handled with the below metrics:
 - Head to Head
 - Point Differential (15 point max per game)
 - Points Allowed cumulative of all games
 - Points Allowed lowest single game
17. All other rules shall be in accordance with the current I.H.S.A. rules.
