### Minor Soccer Program

(U9 - U12)

**Equipment Needed:** Shin Pads (mandatory), sport socks (must fully cover shin pads), cleats recommended, water bottle, warm clothes (toque/gloves/sweatpants), bug spray & sunscreen

**Equipment Provided:** Jersey (players must return this except U9) and soccer ball

## Refund Policy

Original Effective Date:

January 2010

Date of Last Amendment:

If a player withdraws **after registering**, and before Team Formation, an Administration fee of \$25 will be withheld.

If a player withdraws from U9 to U19, **after Team Formation**, an Administration Fee of \$50 will be withheld, as team lists will have been completed and coaches notified.

In the **FIRST TWO WEEKS OF THE SEASON** a refund will be given as follows:

### TIMBITS (U5-U7)

- minus \$25.00 Administration Fee
- minus \$5.00 per scheduled game

### MINOR (U9-U19)

- minus \$50.00 Administration Fee
- minus \$10.00 per scheduled game/practice

When sending in your request please include the following:  
Players Name, Year of Birth, the Reason and Current Mailing Address

Refund cheques will be mailed out.

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**AFTER TWO WEEKS INTO THE SEASON**, a refund will be given **ONLY** for a player who has suffered an injury preventing their return to the season.

**It is the parent's responsibility to notify the office of any season ending injuries, as that is the date the refund will be processed from.**

\*\*A doctor's note will be required to process all refunds associated with season ending injuries.

Please Note: Any individual injured while participating in a MHSA program may be eligible to be reimbursed for some or all of their medical expenses. Please ask about the MHSA's Sport Insurance when processing your refund request.

### \*\*\* NOTE \*\*\*

When the Team Formation process begins, coaches divide players as equally as possible based on the knowledge they have of the children, and evaluation forms from previous seasons, taking into account year of birth within the division. This is a process that coaches invest time in so that the divisions are as balanced as possible, allowing players and coaches to focus on development. Withdrawing after Team Formation has been completed can cause an imbalance to the teams.
