Bats - Bats will be compression tested. Bats that are legal in USA Softball and USSSA and pass our compression test, can be used.

Softballs - Softballs will be provided. Must be 52/300 Composite

Format - 3 Game Guarantee or Double Elimination will be used - Director's discretion

Prize packages and entry fee will vary depending on Tournament Director. Prize and fee are available on each tournament's page.

Rosters will be need to be entered online at www.tournamentusasoftball.com. Or, if the Tournament Director decides otherwise, other arrangements will be made.
