Note: Because of the uneven, but large, number of teams, it is not feasible for every team to play every team (21 games total). If the teams were to be broken into 2 uneven divisions, all teams in the tournament would advance to single elimination except one team. Therefore, it is best to guarantee each team 4 games even though everyone will not play every possible opponent.

In the case of a tie, tiebreakers will apply to head to head, common opponents, and least amount of runs given up during tournament.
