- The Steel won their franchise-record-tying 10<sup>th</sup> game in a row, a 2-0 victory over the Dubuque Fighting Saints on Friday night at Fox Valley Ice Arena ... Chicago went 6-for-6 (100%) on the penalty kill ... With the victory, the Steel have taken wins in 17 of their last 18 contests.
- **Victor Ostman** recorded his first shutout of the year, turning away all 23 shots he faced. He also picked up an assist while improving his record to 16-3-0-1.
- **Erik Middendorf** scored his sixth goal of the season, pushing his point total to 13 (6G, 7A) in 15 games played this year.
- **Gunnarwolfe Fontaine** netted his 17<sup>th</sup> goal of the season; he now has 35 points (17G, 18A).
- **Tyler Carpenter** picked up his 12<sup>th</sup> helper of the year. The forward now has 19 points (7G, 12A) during the 2019-20 campaign.
- **Luke Reid** notched his ninth helper of the season.
- **Uula Ruikka** added an assist to reach the 20-point plateau (4G, 16A).
