Elizabeth Seton Volleyball Championships 2025 Final Four Spectator Guide

Spectator Entry

Spectators must enter the building in the northeast corner of the school—**entering or opening other building doors for spectators will result in immediate removal from the facility.** Spectators will not be allowed in until the building until approximately 30-40 minutes before the first match. Spectators for the girls' matches will be allowed in the building but not be allowed in the gym until the previous matches are concluded. Players and coaches may enter the court area 45 minutes prior to the first matches, or upon the conclusion of the previous matches when directed by the Seton Committee.

Teams are pre-designated a court and side before they enter. Spectators will be routed to their section of the bleachers on their team's side. Please follow the signs/arrows to your team's area to avoid congestion. **Please pay attention and be mindful of balls that may enter the spectator areas during warm-ups!**

Tickets

The Seton is using Just A Game for online ticket sales to speed up the entry and make it easier to pre-purchase your tickets. The Admission cost is (same as paying at the door—no additional online fees will be charged):

Adults (High School & older) - \$6/person

Students (K-8 only) and Seniors (60+) - \$4/person

Kids 5 & under are free

We will be able to accept cash, credit cards, Apple Pay, etc. at the door. If purchasing online, bring your QR code to scan for entry each day. **Please be sure you pick the correct tournament date, as tickets are only good for the day you select and are not refundable.** Tickets may only be redeemed once and will become inactive once redeemed. The Final Four tickets are good for entry at the Boys, Girls Division 2, or Girls Division 1 matches. You may only enter once (must get a hand stamp when you enter to gain re-entry without purchasing another ticket—*no exceptions*).

Tournament Programs, Bag Tags, and T-shirts

The official tournament programs with rosters, team photos, brackets, and more will be on sale at the admissions tables while supplies last. We also have a few Athlete Participant Bag Tags still available. Currently the programs and Bag Tags are \$5 (cash or credit).

If it cuts out or resets please just refresh the page and it should pop back up.

Tripods may NOT be placed in playable areas next to the courts.

NO RUSHING THE COURT AFTER ANY MATCHES ARE COMPLETED! Spectators should remain in the bleachers until directed. Please follow the instructions of the Seton Committee members.

The Seton/Catholic Memorial High School Spectator Rules

We appreciate having everyone present at the tournament to support all of the student-athletes. Please help us make this a positive experience for the players, coaches, and all those involved by abiding by the following rules to enter the tournament. All spectators must follow the directions of the Seton Committee members in neon shirts.

- ***Spectators may not sit in the front row directly behind the court*** (in the service area) but may sit in the front row between the 2 courts. Walkers or wheelchairs must be between the courts or to the side of the bleachers (but not in front of them) to allow the players as much room as possible to serve and pursue balls.
- No spectators may stand in front of the bleachers on the sides or in the team bench area near the courts. Please follow the instructions of the Seton Committee members on areas you may/may not stand.
- **Parents must supervise their children.** *Children should not be running in the hallways, going into the hallways away from the gym, or remaining in the concession area without parent supervision.*
- The Julia Weber (small gym) next to the InPro where games are played is a walk-through area and staging area for teams and coaches only. **NO SPECTATORS/CHILDREN ARE ALLOWED TO PLAY OR REMAIN IN THE JULIA WEBER GYM UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCE!**
- No ballhandling of any kind is allowed at Catholic Memorial outside of the courts (or Julia Weber gym). Balls may not be used in the hallways.
- No artificial noisemakers are allowed (no cowbells, air horns, slap sticks, etc.).
- No flash photography is allowed while either match is being played.
- **Archdiocese of Milwaukee Sportsmanship Pledge** (spectators, coaches, and players agree to this by entering the tournament or facility).
 - As student-athletes, coaches, and spectators at this Archdiocese of Milwaukee event, we pledge to:
 - Display Christian behavior.
 - Show respect for student-athletes, coaches, officials, and spectators.
 - Refrain from profanity, racial and ethnic comments, harassment or taunting of student-athletes, coaches, officials, and spectators.
 - Encourage good sportsmanship by student-athletes, coaches, and spectators.
 - Take responsibility for our actions.
- All cheering should be positive & supportive of your team (team cheers should be celebrating with their teams, not directed towards an opponent). Negative comments or calling out opponents (saying things like “miss it”) will not be allowed.
- Spectators may not enter the playing area, court, or team benches under any circumstance (other than to hand a player a water bottle).
- Spectators may not stand behind the opponent’s bench area.
- Spectators may not yell at or give negative comments towards line judges, officials, coaches, or players. Doing so is grounds for immediate ejection from the tournament without refund. Multiple issues may result in a team forfeiting from the tournament entirely.
- Pom poms, fatheads, and appropriate signs are allowed provided they do not leave debris on the court or delay the matches. Signs should not be held up during play to avoid blocking the view of other spectators. Teams/spectators must remove all items after each match and may be charged if there is excessive clean-up needed on their court.

Concessions

During the Final Four at Catholic Memorial, their Booster Club will run a full concession stand during the matches.

Cash or credit is accepted at CMH concession stand.

Catholic Memorial Wi-Fi

Catholic Memorial High School does NOT have public Wi-Fi available.

Sunday Awards Ceremony

At the conclusion of both matches in each division on championship Sunday, all players and teams will be given awards starting with 4th place and ending with the championship team. Please remain in the bleachers until directed by the Seton Committee. We will have our official photographer take our photo first, then invite parents to take their own pictures before moving on to the next team. Once all teams have received awards for the Boys and Girls Division 2 rounds, teams and spectators must exit the InPro gym to allow for the teams and spectators for the next round to enter.
