- Age expansion for Flag Football, Grades K-2 (4-7), 3-5(8-10), 6-8 (11-14) 7. Future of our tackle program. Is it worth the investment?
 - Can play middle school football and still play flag (not eligible for middle school football and play tackle for PAYAL)
 - We will continue with tackle program while the helmets are still good and revisit in two years once helmets are expired (pending us having enough registrants to fill at least two tackle teams for both Jr. and Sr. divisions)
