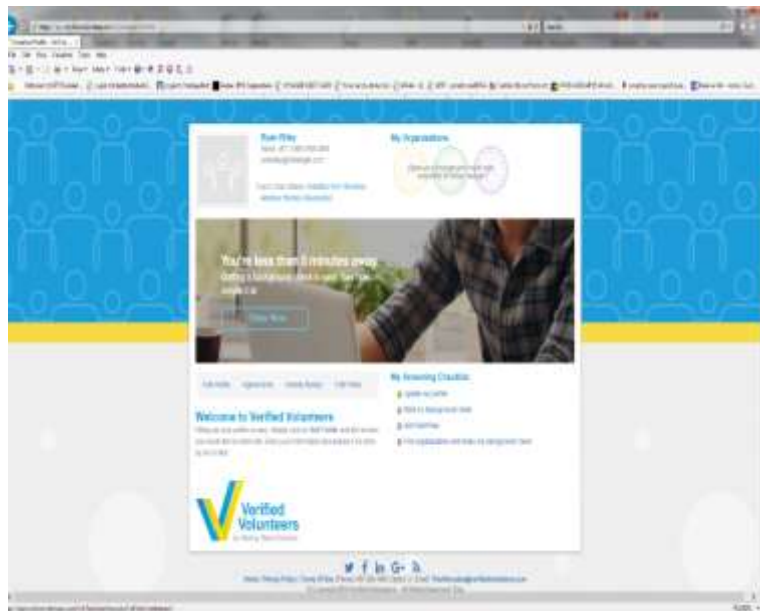

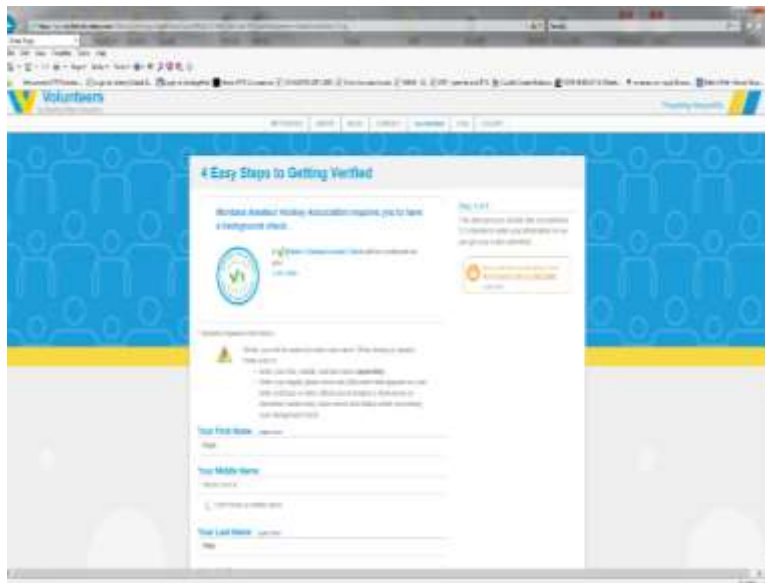

Click GET VERIFIED

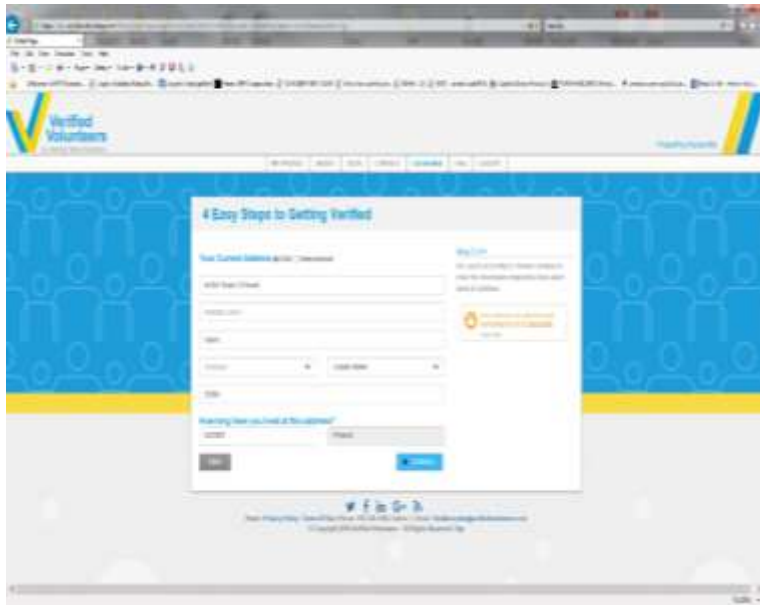
Once you are logged in in and your profile is set up.



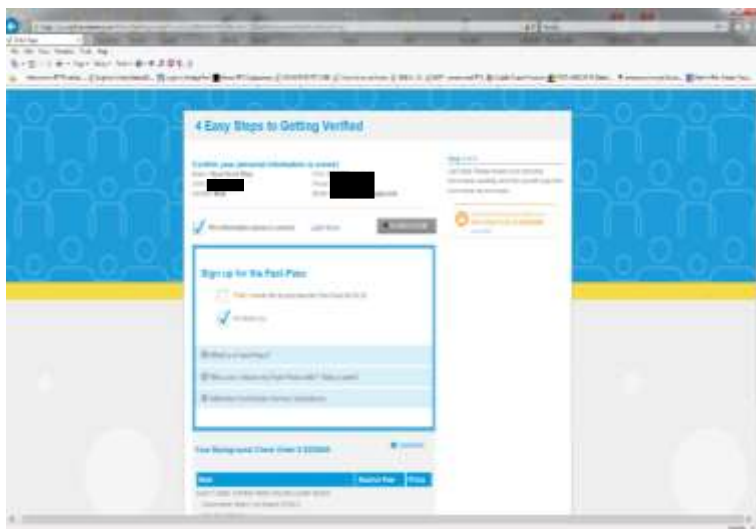
Click on ORDER NOW.
