

Bulverde Soccer – Parent FAQ

When does the season start and how long does it run?

Games begin the weekend of March 7 and the season will run approximately 8–9 weeks.

When are practices held?

Practice days and times are determined by the volunteer coach. Practices are typically held once or twice per week at Jumbo Evans Soccer Complex and do not start before 5:30 PM.

What equipment does my child need?

All players must have shinguards worn under their socks and soccer cleats (no football or baseball cleats). Ball sizes vary by age group.

Are jewelry or earrings allowed?

No. Jewelry of any kind is not permitted during practices or games, including earrings, even if taped.

How are uniforms distributed?

Parents will receive an email with uniform pickup details once uniforms arrive. Uniform pickup will take place at the fields during the week.

When are games played?

Most games are held on Saturdays, with occasional Sunday games due to field availability. Game times vary by age group.

Where are games played?

Games are played at Jumbo Evans Soccer Complex and at various fields around the San Antonio area for travel-rec age groups.

What is expected of parents on the sidelines?

Parents are expected to show respect to players, coaches, referees, and opponents at all times. Positive encouragement is strongly encouraged.
