SHORT-HANDED GOAL: If the opposing team scores a goal while a team is shorthanded, the first penalty (non-coincidental) being served by the "short-handed" team shall terminate.

COINCIDENTAL PENALTIES: When equal # of players on both teams receive minor or major penalties at the same time. Neither team will be short-handed, therefore the **penalized players shall not leave the penalty box until the first stoppage of play following the expiration of their penalties**. These penalties are recorded in the scoresheet but are **not put on scoreboard**.

CONSECUTIVE PENALTIES: When a player commits multiple infractions on the same play, the offending player shall serve penalties consecutively.

STACKED PENALTIES: If more than 2 penalties are assessed to a team, the additional penalties are staggered such that the new one begins as soon as one ends. After being entered, the 3rd (or more) penalty will appear on the scoreboard after previous penalties end. The team will initially skate with 3 players. As penalties expire, **players cannot leave the penalty box until the first stoppage of play following the expiration of their penalties**.

GOALS SCORED DURING A DELAYED PENALTY: The penalty is recorded in the scoresheet, but the player does not serve time in the penalty box.
