Coaches Code of Conduct

The CSCR has adopted the following “Coaches Code of Conduct” and requires all coaches participating in our program to follow these guidelines.

1. The sports offered by CSCR are players' games. The primary concern of coaches is player development, player welfare, enjoyment, and safety of their players.
2. The coaches will be responsible for their players and not allow unsportsmanlike acts toward opponents, officials, or anyone associated with the game.
3. Coaches shall treat officials with respect and dignity. Opponents are also worthy of being treated with respect. Coaches will model such respect for opponents and officials and expect their players to do likewise.
4. Coaches will teach their players the game is not about them, no one is bigger than the game. Instead, by hard work and dedication, they can make the game they play better.
5. Coaches will confine their discussion with game officials to the rules and not challenge officials' decisions involving judgment.
6. Coaches will prohibit comments from the bench and the stands which would include personal and malicious remarks, cursing, and obscene language toward opponents, umpires, coaches, or spectators. A coach is responsible for his/her fans.
7. Coaches will oppose and eliminate all behaviors that bring disrespect to their sport-violence, abuse, dishonesty, disrespect, and gamesmanship. Coaches are required to abstain from using any drugs, alcohol or tobacco products while working with our young athletes.
8. Coaches will refrain from any personal action that might arouse players or spectators to unsportsmanlike behavior.
9. Coaches are required to inform parents and the CSCR board of any code of conduct violations from players, coaches, and parents.
10. Discrimination of any kind will not be tolerated by the CSCR. This includes but is not limited to race, gender, and religion.
