Ice Time

Each session will include a session focus, including skating, stickhandling/shooting and small area games.

Skating

No matter how good your youth player is they need to continue working on skating and stride development. Fall is a great time to review and work on fundamental skating skills.

Stickhandling/Shooting

Develop stick handling, passing, and shooting skills that will give your player the confidence needed to start the season off on the right foot!

Small Area Games

Small area games focus on 1 v 1 battle skills, playing in a small area with quick puck transitions and fast decision making skills needed by today's players.

Kacy Ambroz

Kacy is a New Prague native and played collegiately at the University of Minnesota-Duluth, where she won a National Championship during her 2009-10 season. The Minnesota Whitecaps alum also played professionally in the Czech Republic and Switzerland. Kacy has coached the Boston Blades in the Canadian Women's Hockey League and is currently an assistant coach for the Benilde-St. Margaret's girls hockey team.

Butch Kaebel

Butch played for the St. Louis Blues organization for 13 years. Following his long playing career, he coached in the CHL. Butch has been a professional skating instructor for Dianne Ness' Pro Edge Power for the past 12 years and currently provides year round one on one instruction for division 1 and professional hockey players. He currently works with the Minnesota Wild as a shooting and skating instructor.

John Harrington

John was a four year starter at the University of Minnesota—Duluth. Following his collegiate playing career, John was invited to try out for the US National team coached by Herb Brooks. Harrington made every cut and was placed on the Olympic roster. As a member of the 1980 Gold Medal Olympic Team, he is credited with an assist on the game-winning goal against the USSR in the "Miracle on Ice". John is currently the Minnesota State head women's hockey coach.

Chris Harrington

Chris was a four year starter and captain at the University of Minnesota. He was one of five players to appear in all 45 games for Minnesota's 2002-03 National Championship team, and currently ranks #9 in career points scored as a defenseman at the U of M. Chris has played professionally in the AHL and in Germany.

Karn Skating Dynamics

Barry and Jodi Karn have been teaching full-time together for 30 years, along with Beau Karn for the past 16 years. Over the years Barry has developed a reputation around the NHL that has made him in demand as skating instructor. He works with a growing number of NHL skaters on an individual level during the off-season. The Karns have worked as a skating coach for the Calgary Flames, Tamp Bay Lighting, St. Louis Blues, Chicago Blackhawks, Phoenix Coyotes, New York Islanders, and Minnesota Wild.
