Sarah – Treasurer report

- A lot of recent income from tourney fees, sponsorships, and Super Bowl Squares
- Boosters purchased a VEO game/player tracking system
- Taxes will be getting paid soon
- Midwest Preseason Classic fees and expenses will be coming up

Boys side: Coach Baer –

- Currently 123 players signed up for tryouts
 - Targeting 60-ish total players in the program
 - All players will get to meet with at least 2 coaches and get detailed feedback
- Returning players had spring info meeting and spring schedule was distributed
 - TH 6am returning players futsal sessions
 - T/TH for spring strength workouts
- Strength coach left the program
 - Actively interviewing. Down to 2 finalists
- Conducting bi-weekly futsal sessions for 8th graders
- Summer
 - Sent out an email with current plans
 - Will be starting a bit later this year due to club team schedules
 - 3x per week workouts
 - OHSAA reinstated the 10 contact days rule
 - Applies from 6/1 thru 7/31
 - Includes all showcases

- Futsal is not included and does not count towards this
 - MPC – excited and thankful to move forward and make improvements following last year. Multiple locations will be fine.
- Varsity up for new uniforms
 - Nike supply chain is really bad right now
 - Meeting with seniors to determine designs and go forward plans
- Summer fees
 - More communication coming later in the spring
 - Will include at least 2 showcases, summer shirts, and MPC shirt
- Budget collaboration between board and coaches
 - Very thankful and appreciative of boosters purchasing the VEO system
 - Teams will purchase the analytics and streaming subscriptions
- Coaching staff
 - Added Garrett Szabo as a varsity assistant
 - JV staffs to remain the same

Girls side: Jenn for Coach Schur –

- Very excited for the VEO system
- Almost done creating the summer schedule. Will communicate it out when finished
- Currently have 65 players signed up for tryouts

Midwest Preseason Classic - Debroah

- Scheduled for July 8-10. Boys and Girls the same weekend
 - Kickoff party July 7, 3pm-10pm at 16 Lots
- All games on turf across 3 locations: MHS, CHCA, and Grooms
 - Will be easier to control and manage
- 4 games per team. Games will be from 8am-9pm all 3 days
- Targeting 60 teams
 - 40% full so far
 - Able to reduce the number of teams needed to achieve the fundraising targets
