Celebrating Volunteers in Ontario Volleyball

Achievement Award:

Presented to an individual who has had an impact on volleyball development at the regional or provincial level for 10 years or more.

Ontario Volleyball annually recognizes the outstanding accomplishments and contributions of volunteers, Coaches, Officials, and corporate partners who have distinguished themselves through the years by providing their time, effort and support to the promotion and development of volleyball in Ontario.

Eligibility & Selection Criteria:

- The nominee must be an individual who has made significant strides within the sport of volleyball in one or more of the following categories over a minimum of 10 years:
 - a. Promoting the sport
 - b. History of committed involvement in the sport and performance as an athlete, coach, official, and/or administrator
 - c. Contributes to the development and/or advancement of volleyball in their community
- Must be a member in good standing with the OVA and their community
- The individual may only receive this award once in their lifetime
- Nominee must have previously received the Recognition Award by the OVA
- Nominee must reside in Ontario
- Nominators may only submit one nomination in this category

Submission Requirements:

- A fully completed nomination form. **Must be submitted electronically.**
- A digital head & shoulders photograph of the nominee (jpeg format with 300 dpi).
- A volleyball CV or highlights of accomplishments
