1. Financial Review:
  - a. Paid for breakdown and have "leftover" there... put it towards this season since it was extra from players
2. Parent Meeting/Saber Madness-All teams
  - a. Saber Madness event with the Timberwolves on November 24th, 7pm (75-90 minutes); parent Meeting 5:30
  - b. We need gift cards \$100 total to add to the giveaways, do not need any volunteers for this part the Timberwolves will manage it
    - i. Possibly do 4, \$25 gift cards, but Jake to check with the girls on what they are doing and possibly do larger coordinated gifts with them.
  - c. Angie will order pizza, cookies & water, plates and napkins from Sams Club,
  - d. Amanda will create a sign-up genius for each level and have printed for sign-ups, separate sign up for Holiday Tournament and Cub bagging
    - i. On the sign up, add what the responsibilities are for each night so parents are aware of what they are doing. Include how many people are needed for each night.
    - ii. Draft email to go out before the event letting parents know they can Kwik Trip cards (5 max on this night) \$36 will be the price this year (Sara and Celeste will sell the Kwik Trip cards)

        - b. Volunteers to hand out raffle tickets, culvers ice cream coins, tape off youth section and have some adults to monitor, sell mini basketballs

      3. Glomies - February 10 - Jake can help coordinate
      4. Teacher Appreciation - Thursday, January 15 - 11th grade families organize
      5. Season Cast sign up (V, JV, 10, 9) 9th grade shared
        - a. Check on subscriptions and when they expire
      6. Coaches v. Cancer - Friday, January 23
        - a. Kelly and Alisha Schroeder will lead but will need a committee to support. Will do separate night from the girls program
        - b. Prepare an email to send out asking for volunteers and help with raffle donations.
        - c. Schroeders will take care of shirts, but do need help with sponsors/silent auction items. Baskets of \$200 value, but will take smaller items and combine with others. Shelly Torguson has a gift card and Sara Weir has an IV therapy gift certificate.
        - d. Can you use our tax ID to run pymts through
        - e. Need an individual to donate to...ideally basketball family or school district employee. Send a note to Schroeders if you know of anyone. Jake knows of some teachers with family members dealing with cancer. Could even be someone in youth program.

  - h. Jake will ask Jack Hicks to be here this night for photography
- 3. Cheerleader Season Involvement
- 4. Fundraising
  - a. Kwik Trip Car Wash Cards (sell 11/21- 12/4) – sell 10 to cover cost of travel suit. Highest seller receives \$100 gift card
  - b. Holiday Tournament Concessions & Admissions
  - c. Saber Basketballs - sell at Saber Madness, Youth Night
  - d. Cub Bagging - confirmed Feb 21 & 22
  - e. Half Time Shooting
- 5. Holiday Tournament - separate sign up genius
  - a. Concessions & Admissions (\$7 adults, \$5 senior and \$5 student - confirm amounts)
  - b. 20 team total, 4 towns with 5 teams each - teams don't pay to enter but will pay for the officials
  - c. Varsity - score clock, book and shot clock pay (\$100/game 4 varsity games total)
  - d. Volunteers needed for concessions, entrance, and clock/book for 9th, 10th, and JV
- 6. Photography Updates
  - a. Be Creations - Jolene confirmed for November 22nd at noon (after scrimmage)
    - i. She will also do the senior banners
    - ii. Be Creations did a team banner and we will need a copy to print for youth night
  - b. Approval for Jack Hicks
  - c. Carter Tomes(sp?) also interested
  - d. Approval for Cody Phan -
    - i. Pricing \$100 per game 8 varsity games, 1 game of each other level. He would also do social media to include game day posts for all games
    - ii. Figure out which games for Cody and if he should do just the Var games and ask Jack/Carter T. do the other levels
    - iii. Check with Heidi Lindahl on whether she will take pics of boys on double header nights so Cody doesn't have to come to those games.
      - 1. Ask Cody to confirm what social media he would post – he'll do the post-game/final score posts
        - a. Confirm for parents night, senior night
  - e. Hype video for this year
    - i. Isaiah is planning to do this again this year – need to find a date to this as 11/22 doesn't work for Isaiah.

  - a. Connect with vendor for timeline
- 8. Throw Shirts - pricing
  - a. Ball boy shirts – have them match the throw shirts
  - b. Need to buy silver sharpies – Angie will purchase for both ball boy shifts and youth night team picture signatures
  - c. Brooke (SBBA) will send out sign up to youth for the ball boys
- 9. Ball Boys for Varsity games
  - a. Brooke will send out sign up genius and communication to youth association.
    - i. We will need someone from the Boosters to greet families.

- ii. Brooke typically met families in front row behind bench halfway through JV game
- iii. Record names and give to announcer for introductions
- iv. Ball boys follow team for warm-ups and into the locker room
- v. Boys follow team to locker room at end of game - parents will meet the boys outside of the auxiliary gym to pick up
