The Kawartha Lakes Soccer Club is excited to announce that we have started planning for the 2021 outdoor soccer season, and we expect to be back on the field this summer.

Since the COVID situation is changing daily and we are a few months away from the start of the season, the specific details are still being worked out. The health and safety of our players, coaches, match officials, and families will remain our top priority. The club's Return to Play committee is developing protocols based on the Ontario Soccer Return to Play Guide. In addition, we will also work closely with the City of Kawartha Lakes and the HKPR District Health Unit to ensure that we comply with all COVID regulations.

Players must understand that soccer will certainly be different this year. This may include changes such as new safety protocols, modified rules, and modified league structures. We ask all of our members to be patient and flexible...we will continue to provide more details as the information becomes available. Here is a brief outline of our next steps...

Youth soccer: Over the next two weeks, our Inferno coaches will be reaching out to the families in our youth outdoor program to help determine which teams will be running this summer. We will post the age groups that are looking for more players on our website and social media to recruit new players, as needed. The club will be asking families to register and pay a small deposit so we can prepare for the outdoor season.

Adult soccer: Our convenors will reach out to team captains and players in a few weeks when we know more information. Registration will follow at a later date.

Thank you for your patience and understanding. We are working hard to get everyone back on the field soon, and will continue to provide updated information when it becomes available.
