



Female Director

The Female Director serves as the primary point of contact for all matters related to female hockey within Prairie Storm Minor Hockey Association (PSMHA). This role is responsible for supporting players, teams, coaches, managers, and families, while promoting the growth and development of female hockey within the association.

The Female Director is expected to respond to communication related to female hockey (issues, concerns, or general information) in a timely manner (within 48 to 72 hours), and to actively assist with and participate in female-focused initiatives and events.

Responsibilities include:

- Work collaboratively with Division Directors in divisions where female teams are present to support team operations and address division-specific needs
- Work collaboratively with Female Directors from other associations to share best practices, coordinate initiatives, and support the overall growth of female hockey
- Assist in planning and executing female hockey events within PSMHA (e.g., Female Come Try Hockey, World Girls' Hockey Day, Esso Fun Days)
- Act as the primary contact for membership inquiries related to female hockey opportunities within PSMHA
- Provide recommendations to the PSMHA Board of Directors regarding female development opportunities
- Conduct research to identify barriers to female participation and recommend strategies to enhance the female hockey experience within PSMHA
- Prepare and present monthly reports to the PSMHA Board of Directors
- Attend PSMHA Board of Directors meetings as required
- Support female player recruitment initiatives, as well as recruitment of head and assistant coaches for female teams
- Attend Saskatchewan Female Hockey League meetings as required (including the Annual General Meeting and seasonal coordination meetings), and act as a liaison between PSMHA and the league
