\*You must register before attending a tryout.

Baseball Eligibility: Player must be of age based on the upcoming season.

U9 = age 9 or younger as of April 30, 2022  
U10 = age 10 or younger as of April 30, 2022  
U11 = age 11 or younger as of April 30, 2022  
U12 = age 12 or younger as of April 30, 2022  
U13 = age 13 or younger as of April 30, 2022  
U14 = age 14 or younger as of April 30, 2022

#### Things to know:

- Players are required to attend 1 tryout date, but can attend both. The highest evaluation score for each respective skill will be used for each player's overall score.
- Invitations to the team will be sent as soon as scores are compiled on July 29<sup>th</sup> and responses to those invitations will be requested within 24 hours. There can be more than 1 team per age level.
- Making the team is not guaranteed and will be evaluated by individuals who are not parents of the players trying out for the teams.
- Be sure to read the HEAT FAQs on our website. In short we offer:
  - Competitive leagues
  - Indoor winter facilities with practices 2-3 times per week
  - Outdoor spring/summer practices 2-3 days per week
  - Local, weekend tournaments April through mid-July. A few tournaments could be short travel.
  - Up to 35 games per season depending on age level.

#### Here's what you need to do:

- Complete the online registration at [tmyba.org/reg](http://tmyba.org/reg) by July 27.
- Come to the tryout dressed in baseball attire if possible.
- Bring your own equipment if possible. (bat, glove, helmet, etc.)
- Arrive early to warm up.
- Check-in table opens at 5:30. Stop there to receive your tryout number.

#### Here's what to expect:

- Players will move through stations and be evaluated by volunteer coaches and parents. The coach for the team you are trying out for will not be conducting the evaluation.
- Players will be evaluated for running speed, fielding, throwing, catching, batting, pitching (optional) and catching (optional, bring your own equipment if possible).
- Tryouts will take up to 2 ½ hours to complete depending on how many players attend for each age group.
- Parents can stay during tryouts, but please do not be distracting or "coaching" your child during tryouts.
