“EDUCATION THROUGH SPORT”

Friday, January 22, 2021

There has been no change to the current Public Health Measures. We are seeing a continued high number of COVID-19 cases in Regina and surrounding areas. School divisions have made decisions regarding winter extracurricular sports programs, supported by RHSAA. These follow Saskatchewan Ministry of Education, the Business Response Team and the Saskatchewan Health Authority’s recommendations relating to student and staff safety.

- The current winter sports season will not proceed as the Business Response Team and Saskatchewan Health Authority have directed no competitions to occur in the province until late March 2021. **To clarify, no inter-school competitions will take place before Easter/Spring Vacation in April 2021.**
- School divisions intend to meet in March to consider spring sports seasons, in school training options and small cohort competition between schools.
- **More direction will be provided in March. Once decisions have been finalized, RHSAA will inform all concerned parties.**

RHSAA school divisions are recommending that questions or concerns from parents, students or employees relating to high school athletics first be referred to vice-principals or principals, and finally to division offices.

Regina school divisions and the RHSAA continue to provide full support to schools, administrators, teachers, coaches, officials, volunteers, and, most importantly, their student athletes when they are able to begin a safe return to ‘Education Through Sport’. The RHSAA will work with the Saskatchewan Health Authority, the SHSAA, Regina school divisions and senior administrations to ensure this occurs.

The RHSAA represents Regina Catholic Schools, Regina Public Schools, Luther College, Huda School, Laval Ecole, Regina Christian School and Harvest City Christian Academy. Please refer to their websites for how they will be responding to the provision of athletics during COVID-19.

The RHSAA is thankful for the continued support and patience, as well as the tireless work done on behalf of Regina high school athletes by our member divisions and all those that support high school athletics.
