Meeting Called to Order By: President Jeanna Townsend

General Manager Report – James Soesbee

- Referee Coordinator Damian has requested a per-game pay increase. Financials will be reviewed before a decision is made.
- ESC received a donation of approximately 28,000 sq. ft. of artificial turf from Skiatook.
- First Fidelity Bank has expressed interest in sponsoring an awning.
- Members interested in hosting a foreign exchange student should contact James.
- Awaiting city repairs for damaged poles and netting on site.
- ESC website update is nearly complete with final adjustments underway.

Assistant GM Report – Gary Boreham

- ESC coaches may use designated fields for private lessons during the summer.
- Playoff teams will also be granted access to fields.
- Tommy Hubbard and Danny Roberts will lead coordination of the Summer Blast Tournament.

Academy Director Report – Michael Moritz

- Finalizing the lower half of the coaching slate.
- Matt Bray will be removed from coaching responsibilities following Memorial Day.
- Coaching responsibilities and website content are currently being updated.

Recreational Director Report – Tommy Hubbard

- One conduct issue under committee review from the rec season.
- Ongoing concern: players standing in front of the goal during 4v4 matches. Directors are working on solutions.
- Fall registration begins June 1.
- Summer camp scheduled for July 21–24.
- Mojo app usage and engagement continue to increase; spring saw more utilization than fall.
- Despite numerous rainouts, nearly all games were rescheduled and played. Acknowledgment to Gary for scheduling and referee coordination.
- Center of Excellence program was strong with organized coaching. Only 6 of 7 sessions completed — \$15 discount to be given to all spring participants for the fall.

- Rec goalkeeper training began strong but attendance dropped due to cancellations and closures. Feedback was still positive.
- Overall, a solid spring season given weather challenges.

- Requesting OSA support to fund jerseys.
- Would like to attend the national coaching clinic in Kansas City.

- Board voted and approved the incoming board members.

1st Vice President Report – Matt Boeckman

- Working on medals and awards for the upcoming Beat the Heat tournament.

Competitive Chair Report – Luke Richardson

- OEFC will soon release new uniforms.
- NOKC will use the new fields for games only.

Complex Coordinator Report – Dan Weinmeister

- Fertilization scheduled for May 28.
- All fields have been aerated.
- Top dress machines used across all fields – cost approx. \$5,500.
- 14 loads of compost ordered for topdressing – approx. \$12,000.
- Installing new irrigation at the main entrance – approx. \$14,000.
- Grading drainage to the main drain – approx. \$6,000.
- Sprigging/sodding around goal mouths and bare areas – approx. \$3,000.
- Monitoring Rye grass during summer. If Bermuda performs well, plan to overseed 4–5 fields this fall.
- May need additional sand for leveling ruts and improving drainage.
- Total estimated investment for spring field rehab: \$40,500.
- Board voted to approve the Spring Field Rehabilitation Plan.
