-427 items were sold this season totaling \$13,621.64 in sales with a fundraiser donation of \$1,152 back to the association

-\$2,829 raised this year

## Pink the Rink – Sonya

-Approximately \$11,000 was raised after expenses. \$5,400 will be donated to Siouxland Sled Hockey with a check presentation 02/16/2024 in Brookings as both MSHA and Siouxland Sled Hockey will be there. A \$3,600 donation will be presented to Heart and Soul from the event. Sonya is waiting on the t-shirt proceeds payment and the payment for the GV socks to finalize the final number.

## Concessions – Roxi Z

-Conversations were had regarding pulling a top 10 items sold and the worse 10 items sold to be given to Roxi for evaluation. Maybe simplifying the menu will help to decrease the cost as sales are in line with the budget this year but food and drink cost are much higher. Discussion was had regarding a transition plan as Roxi’s skater will be a senior next year.

## Golf Tournament -Jaycent

-Discussion was had regarding concerns for the golf tournament with the changes Wild Oak is making by only having a 9-hole course. Different types of tournament were discussed on how

to run the tournament at Wild Oak with the changes. Lakeview Golf course is full for tournaments already and isn't an option. Jaycent would like to keep the budget at \$8,500.

-Budget for next year will be \$12,500. All most all the tickets got sold with a huge help from adding Venmo. We are looking to make a little over \$12,000 on the fundraiser.
