Great news! FVHA's Learn to Skate Program will be free this year. Registration is open for LTS on our website with an anticipated start date in mid November

All registrations from Learn to Skate to Mite/Minimite to travel teams and equipment rental are currently on our FVHA website. USA Hockey members registration is open now and USA Hockey membership is a requirement of our program.
