Pool Play/Warm-ups

Gym opens at 7:10 a.m. **Coaches: Check in at the table at the Fieldhouse-Coaches meeting at 7:40 am.**

All pools will begin their first match at **8:00 am**. There will be a 10 minute (2-4-4) warm up for each team's first match only. A 5 minute (1-2-2) warm up will follow for the remainder of day. Pool play matches will be 3 games to 25 points, NO CAP! Balls are NOT provided for warm-up so please make sure to bring your own. Liberos can serve for any one spot in the lineup.

Playoffs

Playoffs will follow immediately pool play. DURING THE LAST ROUND OF POOL PLAY, there will play a single play-in round between the two lowest ranked teams of the 7 teams NOT PLAYING, length will be determined based upon the time. The top two teams from each pool will play in the Gold Pool. The highest ranked 2 seed will also go into gold pool. The four remaining teams (one of them the winner of the play-in game) will go in the Silver Pool. Matches for playoffs are 2/3 (25-25-15 points). **Gold Pool Champions only will receive T-shirts. Tournament Director reserves the right to make changes if deemed necessary. Please keep an eye on the official brackets posted at the Directors table.**

Division/Seed breakdown and placement in playoffs will be decided by:

1. Overall Game Percentage in Pool
2. Head to Head, then H-to-H point differential
3. Match win/loss
4. Overall Point Differential
5. Coin Flip

Officiating

All teams are responsible for providing their own officiating equipment. During playoffs, everyone must check-in with tournament director before leaving. Any team late for an officiating assignment and/or competition will be penalized. These teams will lose a point for every minute they are late. Please check with the site director before you leave to make sure your team has no further officiating duties. **Coaches will be required to control the match as one of the referees within all age groups.** The officiating team must provide a first referee, second referee, scorekeeper, libero tracker, score operator, and two line judges.

Other

There are no potlucks or team dinners allowed in this facility. Concessions will be available for purchase as well as other merchandise. Ice/band-aids will be available for injuries at the Directors Table, but no athletic trainer is on site.

Admissions/Parking/Directions

General admission for all non-coaches and players is \$5 for ages 5 and up (under 5 are free). All tournament fans/participants should park in the M or K lots. Enter at Door 1- go through the SCSU Hall of Fame, turn right, proceed down hallway to the stairs (on your right) and go all the way to the basement for the Fieldhouse entrance.
