



Le Sueur Community Center COVID-19 Arena Restrictions
Updated 10-24-2020

Masks: Are required to be worn at all times by coaches, players and spectators. Masks must be worn by spectators even when seated in the bleachers. Players are not required to wear masks while participating on the ice for games/scrimmages.

Timing of Arrival: Players and coaches may not enter the Le Sueur Community Center (LSCC) more than 15 minutes before game time. Any players arriving earlier than 15 minutes before their start time should wait outside of the facility. Minnesota River parent volunteers will be there to let players and spectators into the building as all doors are key card entry only. Spectators will be allowed to enter the community center 5 minutes before game time. The parent volunteers will only remain at the door until 5 minutes after game time has started.

Dressing: Dedicated locker rooms will be available for skates and helmets ONLY. Players must enter the arena dressed in complete gear with the exception of helmet, gloves and skates. Exception: goalies may put on their leg pads in the arena. No dressing or undressing will be allowed in the locker rooms. Large hockey bags are not allowed. Players may bring in a small bag to carry their water bottle, helmet, gloves and skates. Masks must be worn at all times while in the locker room until players are ready to put their helmet on and go on the ice.

Water Bottles: Players should fill and bring their own water bottle to the arena in a clearly marked bottle. Players should not share their water bottles. Although the water fountain bottle filling station is working, players are strongly encouraged to have their water bottles filled and already to prevent players from congregating in one area for a long period of time.

Spectators: A maximum of two (2) adult spectators per player are allowed for games.

Siblings, 15 years old and younger, are welcome, however they must sit and be with the parent/guardian at all times. The sibling should not be running around in the hallways or in the mezzanine. Siblings 15 years old and younger will not count towards the two (2) spectators per player. Masks are required at all times inside the community center and arena. Masks must be worn even when seated in the bleachers. Minnesota River Youth Hockey reserves the right to take attendance by presenting a ticket or stamp upon entry to the arena to ensure we are in compliance.

Concession Stand: Will be open when possible to prepackaged items only.

Coaches on Benches: No more than two (2) coaches allowed on the bench area during games. Coaches on the bench must wear a mask at all times.

Post Game: There should be no pregame or postgame handshakes.

Leaving the Arena: Spectators should exit the arena immediately after the completion of the game, using the new exit (please follow signage). Players should exit the locker room and the arena immediately after taking off their helmet, gloves and skates.
