



## COVID-19 Pandemic Preparedness & Response Plan for Reopening the Hamden Rink – Hamden, CT

595 Mix Management LLC has developed the following COVID-19 Pandemic Preparedness & Response Plan for Reopening based on the procedures outlined by USA Hockey and in alignment with provisions set forth by the CDC and WHO.

**To ensure safety of our customers, the following protocols will be put in place.**

### Cleaning/Disinfecting

- **High Traffic Areas** – Cleaning intervals will be increased to ensure a safe environment. Athletes in locker rooms will be limited to 6 players at one given time period. Players will be asked to dress and exit the locker area immediately to get on the ice surface. Congregating in common areas will not be allowed.
- **High Touch Objects** – Doors, handles, light switches, handrails, vending machines and faucets in the restrooms will be done 3-4 times daily
- **Office work** – Any office work will be done remotely until further notice
- **Concession stand** – Will be closed until further notice
- **Player Benches/Penalty Boxes/Scoreboard controllers** – Will be disinfected hourly in between user groups
- **Tools/equipment** – All operational controls, equipment and tools will be disinfected following each shift and between use, if feasible by every worker
- **Floors** – Will be mopped 3-6 times daily
- **Locker Rooms** – Customers will be assigned to specific rooms upon entry. Every locker room will be marked to maintain 6 ft distancing and will be disinfected prior to and after each groups use. All locker room doors will be propped open.
- **Common Area** – All players will enter in the rink lobby. All spectators will only be allowed to enter directly from the parking lot.

- **Customer Compliance** – Each customer will assign a member of their program to assist rink staff in maintaining the rules outlined above.

### **Infection Prevention**

- **Handwashing** – Staff has been instructed to wash their hands for at least 20 with soap and water throughout the day. Alcohol based hand sanitizer will be provided throughout the facility
- **Masks/gloves** -- All workers will be wearing masks throughout their designated shift. They have been instructed to limit interaction with customers to within 6 feet. Also, when cleaning and/or disinfecting, all workers will be required to wear gloves. They will be instructed to immediately wash their hands when their gloves are removed. All spectators will also be required to wear a mask.
- **Social distancing** – Signs will be posted throughout the rink for all people to stand 6ft apart when entering the building

### **Other general Measures.**

- All booking ice and payments will all be done remotely thereby eliminating contact with staff
- Points of entry and exit will be designated to assure strict monitoring of access and sanitation on an hourly basis.
- Non athletes will only be allowed to enter from the top parking lot and will not be allowed to stand on the glass to watch practice/games
- Ice times will be booked with spacing to prevent engagement between customers entering and exiting
- All rules outlined by USA Hockey will be strictly enforced
- Staff will be trained to give friendly reminders to customers regarding policies, especially when they are found to be in violation of outlined safety precautions
- ALL on ice rink programs will be operated following USA hockey's social distancing recommendations.
