# Planning for a “Regular” Season



(Coach Ganey)

- Off-season Training: Eureka CrossFit
  - *Recommended for athletes not in fall sports*
  - *Team sessions: 4:00 – 5:00 pm*
  - *\$85 per month; includes unlimited access*
    - Payable to Eureka CrossFit
  
- Fall Lacrosse: October 4-November 8
  - *Liberty Field - Pacific*
    - Sundays 11 am - 1 pm
    - Wednesday and Thursday 5 pm until dusk
  - *Incoming/Freshmen players are especially encouraged*

# Planning for a “Regular” Season



- Fall Tournaments and Events: TBD
  - *7v7 at Lindenwood*
  - *7v7 Pumpkin Shootout*
  - *Public School Jamboree – Tentatively November 7*
  
- Winter Training: Rockwood United
  - *January through Early February*
  - *Indoor practices – in conjunction with other Rockwood School Affiliated clubs*

# Planning for a “Regular” Season



## ■ Spring Season

- *Practices regularly start in late February.*
- *These will be five days per week.*
- *The expectation is that all players will participate in each practice.*
- *Regular season games begin in March.*
- *Required practices during EHS Spring break.*
  
- ***There may be a mandatory Spring Break trip for Varsity players. Possibly: Memphis***

# Planning for a “Regular” Season



- There may be a trip for JV and Varsity players this season.
  - *These trips will include bus transportation, hotel and meals for all players and coaches.*
  - *The club will collect additional per player fees to cover trip expenses.*

# 2020-21 Fees and Fundraisers



(Craig Stebor)

- We rely on registration fees and fundraising activities to operate the high school program
- 2020-21 projected expenses for the Fall and Spring high school program: \$39,800
  - ~\$1,000 *per player (assumes 40 registered players)*
    - Coaching salaries, field rental and field supplies, league fees, uniforms, officials, trainers
    - Nearly all are fixed expenses – don't change much with the number of players participating



# 2020-21 Registration Fees



- High School Lacrosse Registration: \$1,000 per player
  - *\$250 due at registration*
    - <http://bit.ly/ELCHSREG2021>
  - *Balance due before Spring practice begins*
  - *Freshman players who have participated in Youth programs receive a one-time fee discount*

# 2020-21 Fundraising



## ■ Individual Fundraiser: Pizza Sales

- *100% of the profit from a player's pizza sale will be credited to that player's account*

- Mr. Fundraising: Fundraising profit is 40%

## ■ Club Fundraisers

- *All proceeds will be applied equally to registered players*

# 2020-21 Fundraising



- The balance due before spring practice begins will be a calculation based on:
  - *Net proceeds from club fundraising activities divided by the number of registered players*
  - *Net proceeds from individual pizza sales*

# 2020-21 Fundraising



(Sheldon)

## Why the change?

- Many previous fundraisers will not be feasible this season
  - *Trivia Night: ~\$9,750 last season*
  - *Sponsorships: ~\$6,500 last season*
  
- No buy-out option or minimum requirements in 2020-21

# 2020-21 Refund Policy



**If the season is canceled or cut short (again) due to COVID-19:**

- Prorated registration fee refunds will be issued based on the cancellation date and net of club expenses incurred
- Any refund will be based on out-of-pocket registration fee payments made to the Eureka Lacrosse Club.
- Fundraising proceeds will not be refunded.
