The Titans then stepped it up with a strong defensive performance in goal by Annika Newell and closed out the half 13-7.

In the second half the draw was key and Mary Grace Reynolds, Jasmine Marval and Meg Bireley dominated at the circle. The team

switched up their defensive strategy and held the fillies to just 4 goals.

The team advances to super-sectionals Tuesday at Lake Zurich vs Stevenson High School.





Titans win Regional!

GBS Baseball had a strong week starting with a non-conference game on Monday against a tough Nazareth team. The Titans won 4-2 behind

a strong combined effort from the pitching staff. Ryan O'Hara, Kevin Redfern, Zach Carr, Matthew Lau (jr), and Declan Hood combined to only give up 1 earned run striking out 7 Nazareth batters. Zac Malis (jr) helped lead the offense with a double and 2 RBI's. Luke Smith (jr) chipped in with 2 runs scored and a stolen base.

On Thursday, the Titans took on a confident Jones Chicago team. GBS was losing 2-0 the whole game until the offense woke up to put up 3 runs in the bottom of the 6th inning led by a Brandon Matias double that scored 1 run and Ryan O'Hara who had 2 hits and an RBI. Danny Pauletto (jr) and Joseph Shapiro (jr) were lights out on the mound going 7 innings, allowing 0 earned runs and striking out 4.

Saturday brought the Regional Finals against Notre Dame (Niles). The Titans took the lead early going up 6-2 after 6 innings. The offense was led by Brandon Matias who had 2 hits and 2 RBI's. George Korompilas (so) had a timely line drive to center field to plate another run and Ryan O'Hara had 2 hits including a double with 3 RBI's.

On the mound, Ryan O'Hara was in control most of the night going 6.2 innings, striking out 8 (O'Hara recently committed to playing at the University of Illinois). Notre Dame would not go quietly, though, as they scored 3 runs in the 7th inning and had the tying run on second base when Declan Hood ultimately struck out the last batter to slam the door on the Dons and make GBS the Regional Champions.

Next step - on to Sectionals! The Titans will take on Lane Tech on Wed., May 29, at 7 p.m., at Loyola Academy's home fields on John's Drive.

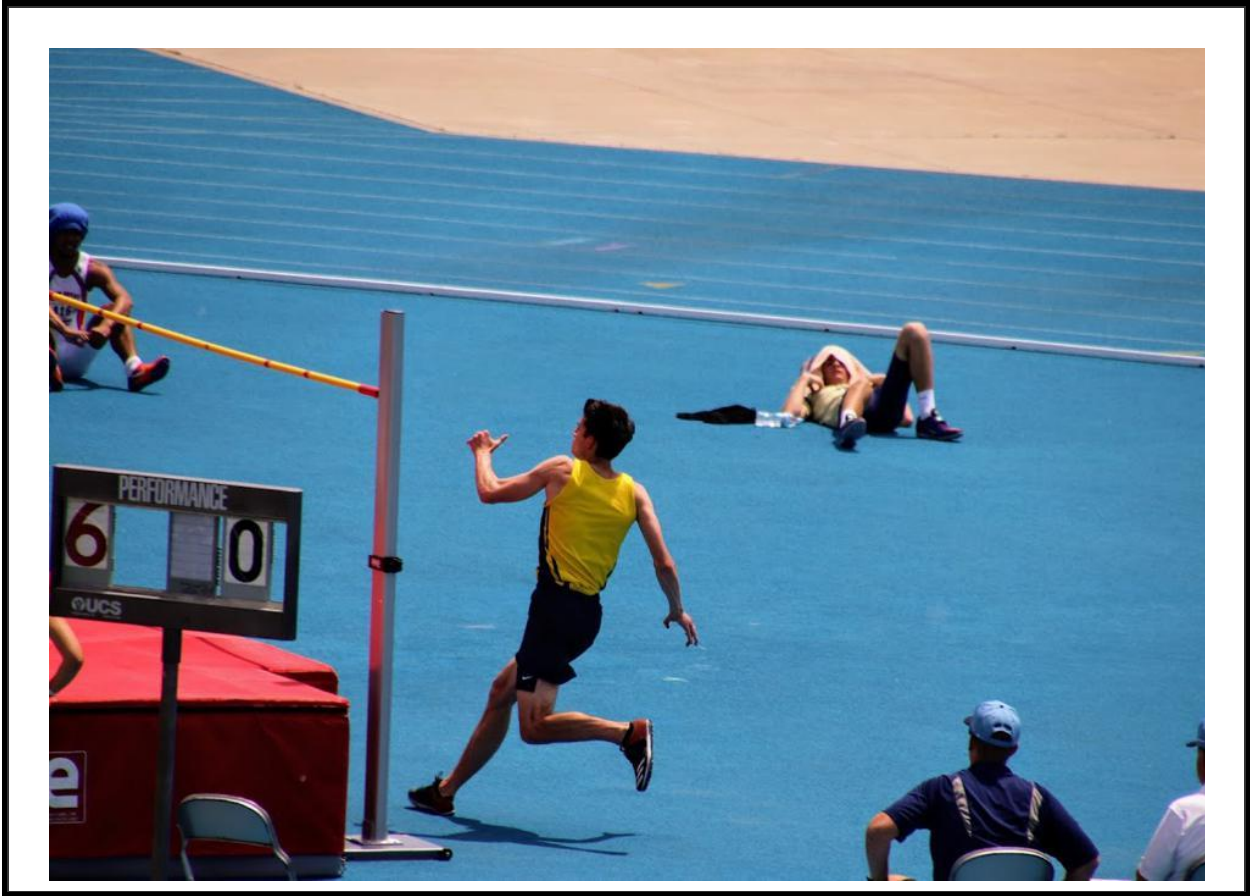
Boys Track & Field Competes at State Championships

Girls Soccer Falls in Sectional Final

Makayla Stadler's two goals weren't enough for Glenbrook South, who lost to New Trier 3-2 Friday, May 24, in the New Trier Sectional final in Northfield.

With 15 minutes remaining, Emma Weaver curved in the game-winning goal about 30 yards out from a free-kick position.

While it was an unbelievable shot, Glenbrook South head coach Mark Daniels believed his squad could have stopped before it even happened.

"We could have stopped the shot without fouling in the first play," Daniels told the Glenview Lantern. "If we don't foul, then she wouldn't have scored."

After a sectional semifinal game against Evanston in which they turned the ball over on multiple occasions, Glenbrook South focused on

possession soccer. During practice, they played keep-away games, executed diagonal runs, and made pattern passes. But New Trier's heavy pressure-style is nigh-impossible to emulate.

"But it all comes back to not panicking or kicking it away," Daniels said. "Switching the play. I can't say we all have confidence with the ball. New Trier is on you, so you can't have a bad touch. I'm not going to be critical about our play, but we didn't get the job done."

Offensively, Glenbrook South was solid. The Titans had five corners and eight shots-on-goal. Before the game, their team discussed two points: 1) pressuring their backs and; 2) placing corner kicks.

"My first goal, we talked before the game about pressuring their backs," Stadler said. "So that's exactly what I did. One of their defenders mistouched it, so I was able to get it in the back of the net."

In terms of corner kicks, their specialist, Katie Sullivan, had only been healthy for the last six games. As a result, a few of their corners had been misplaced. But once a corner kick was well-placed, Stadler capitalized, as she does so often.

"On the second goal, corner kicks have been a struggle for us lately," Stadler said. "Katie Sullivan placed a perfect corner kick, so luckily I was in the right place, right time."

Looking ahead, Makayla Stadler headlines the group of 12 Glenbrook South seniors who are graduating on June 2. Stadler is attending Villanova next season, where she'll play for a year before being joined by Weaver.

"Her competitiveness brings out the competitiveness in me," Stadler said. "She makes me a better player. And we actually played club together. Seeing the things she does, I'm upset she's not on our team obviously. I'm excited to play with her."

In the sectional semifinal vs Evanston, the Titans won on penalty kicks.

Katie Sullivan scored the game-tying goal to send the game to OT. Freshman Lily O'Rourke just scored the game-winning goal. Goalie

Libbie Vanderveen made 3 huge saves in the shootout to secure the win.

The Titans record for the season was 21-4-2!

Raise Money for Titan Athletes, Sign Up for the 2019 Hero Hustle 10K/5K

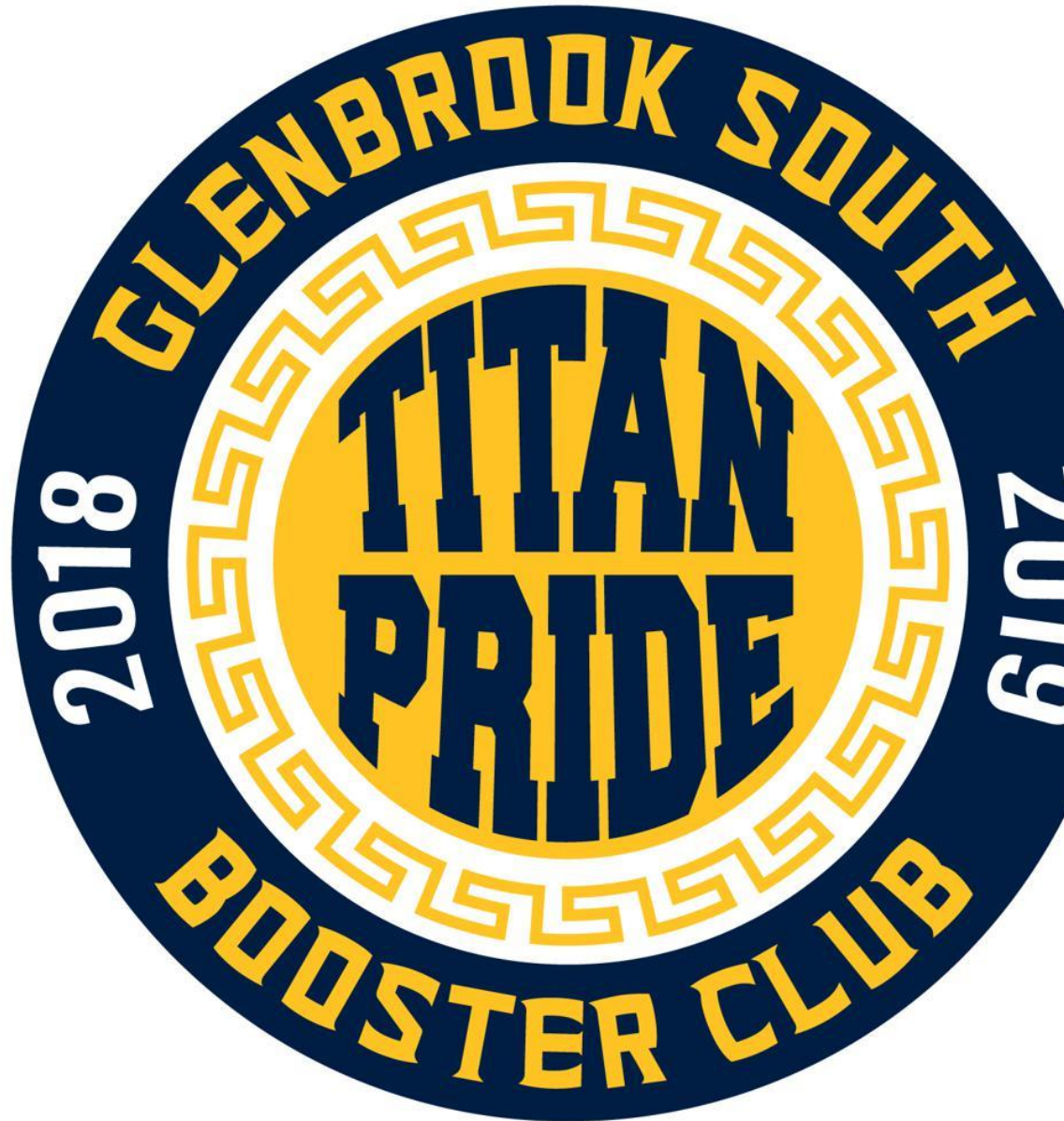

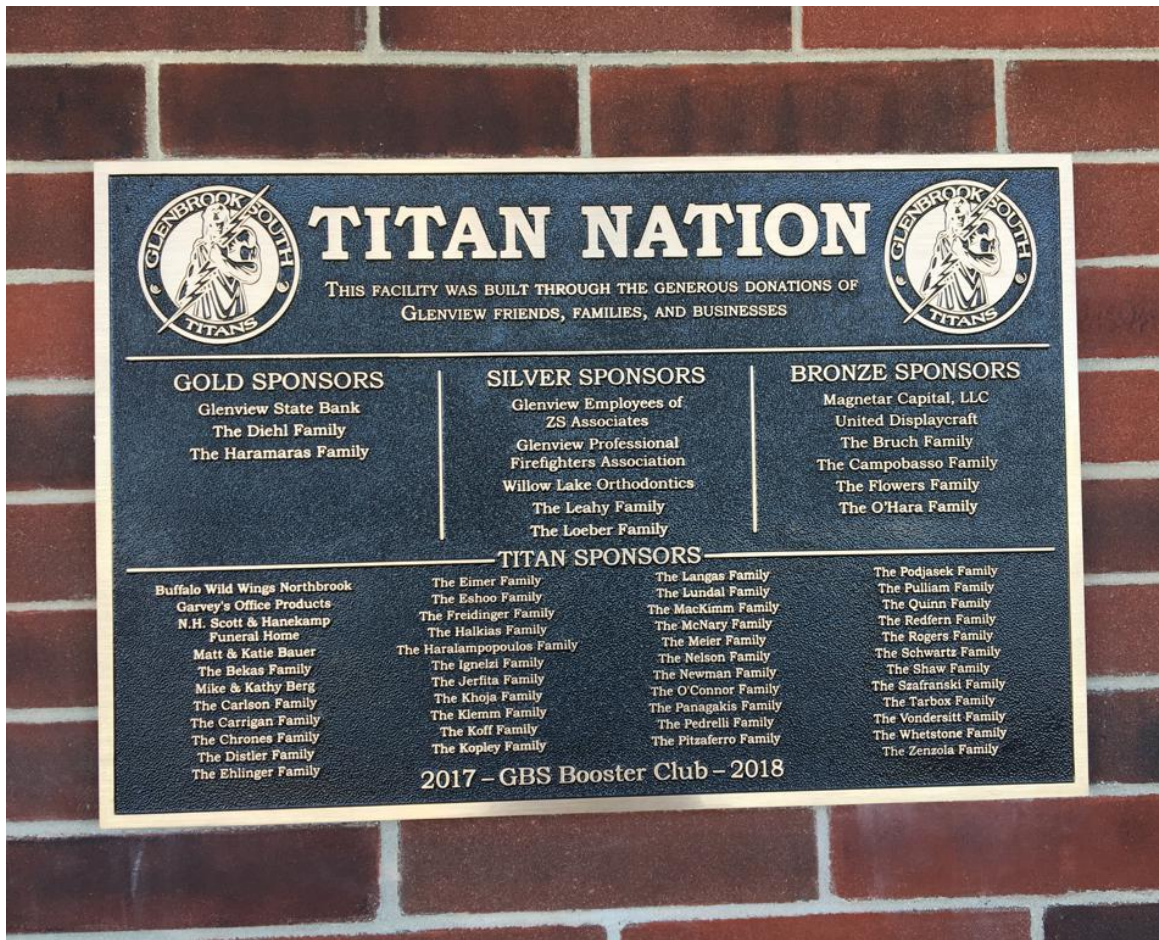
