

# Easton Ice Hawks Gameday Protocol



It is our goal to keep all who enter the ice rink as safe as possible.

**Everyone who enters the Talbot County Community Center (TCCC) must wear a face covering over their nose and mouth at all times.** The only exception to this rule is for referees **who are on the ice.** Coaches and players must wear face coverings over their nose and mouth at all times, including while on the bench or ice.

## DO NOT ATTEND IF:

You have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days

You have any symptoms of COVID-19

**You feel unwell and/or have symptoms of any illness**

You have been around someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days

## ARRIVAL GUIDELINES:

**Players, coaches, team managers, and ESHA scorekeepers and clock operators only will enter the building through the hockey entrance.** This is located at the back of the building. Teams may enter 15 mins prior to game time and need to be fully dressed with the exception of helmets, gloves, and skates. We will provide your team with a place to put that equipment on. Goalies will be allowed to enter 30 mins prior to game time and may put on all their gear inside the rink. Players are required to bring their own water bottle and these bottles must be filled prior to arriving, as the water fountains have been shut off.

**Only household family members (parents and siblings) of the player(s) are allowed to attend 8U Jamborees, no other spectators will be permitted.** For all other age groups (10U-18U) additional spectators, other than household family members, may attend. Parents, guardians, and spectators may only enter through the main doors of TCCC 10 mins prior to the game time. They must have a face covering on over their nose and mouth at all times, and they must stay socially distanced in approved viewing areas. **If you have siblings that are attending, they must remain with their parents/guardians at all times.**

## DEPARTURE GUIDELINES:

Following the game, parents, guardians, and spectators are asked to immediately leave through the main doors; do not walk over to the players' side of the rink. Players must quickly remove skates, gloves, and helmets and exit through the player's entrance. Coaches, managers, and team personnel will also exit through the player's entrance.

## ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES

- **There is no food or drink allowed in the facility.**
- Please follow all signage and guidelines that are posted.
- LiveBarn is connected and will be broadcasting all games played at the TCCC.
- **There is a zero-tolerance policy at the TCCC regarding the following of these rules, as well as USA Hockey's Zero Tolerance Policy.**
- Referees will have use of the referee room. They must always wear a cloth face covering over their nose and mouth, except while on the ice. To the extent possible, individuals engaged in on ice activities shall wear a face covering, especially when social distancing is not feasible.
