 - Verbiage, formations, play calls, etc.



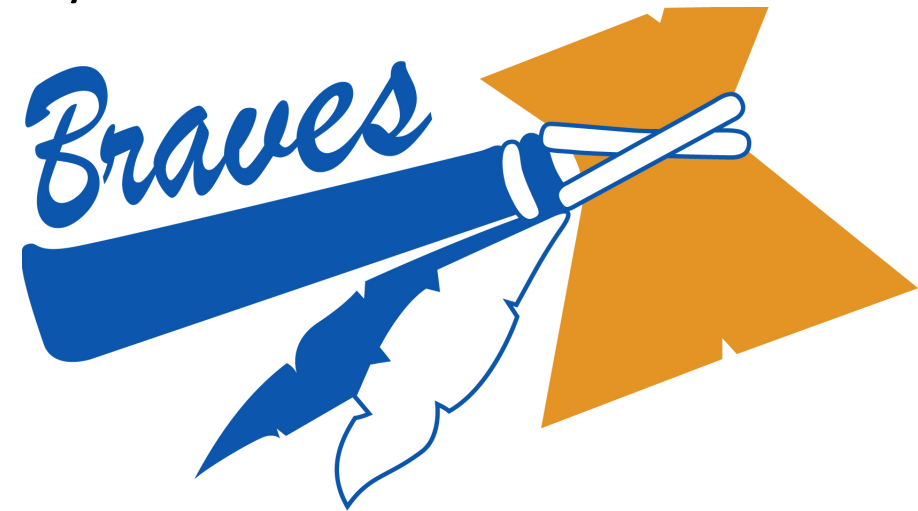

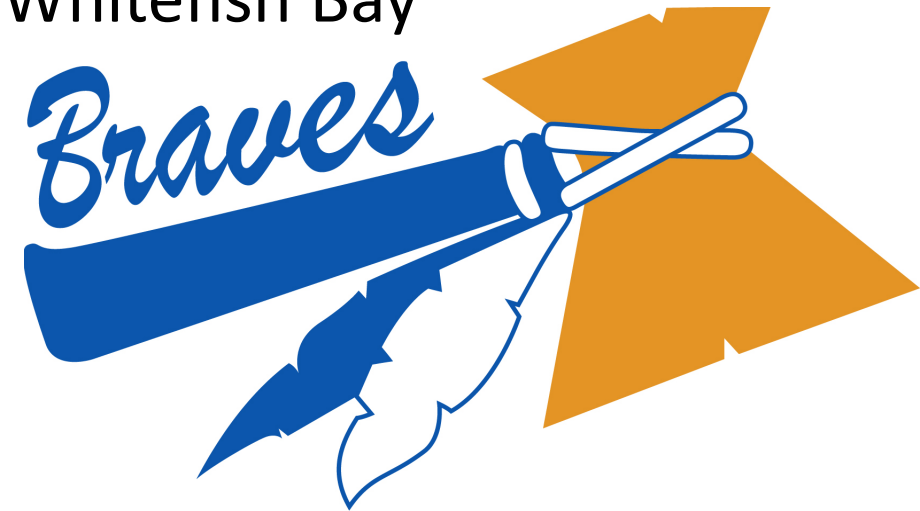
Practices and Scrimmages

Fundraising

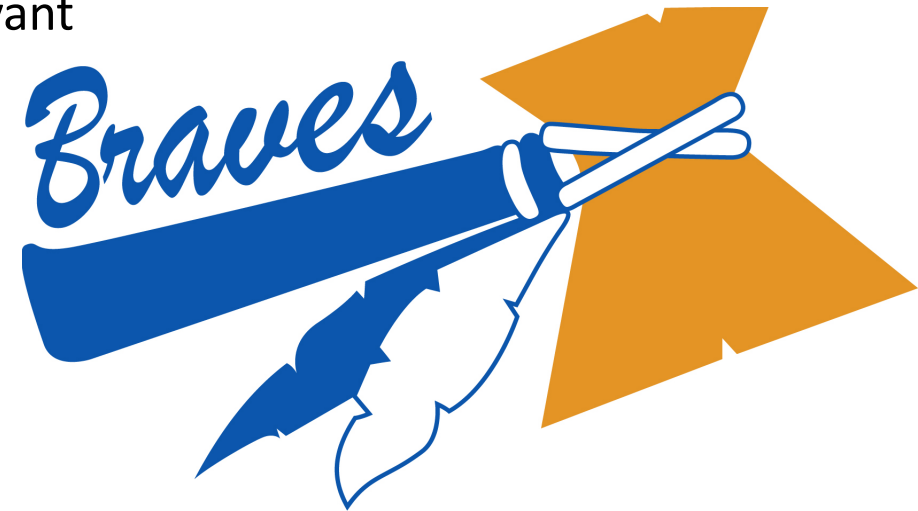
- Cookie Dough Sales

Fundraising

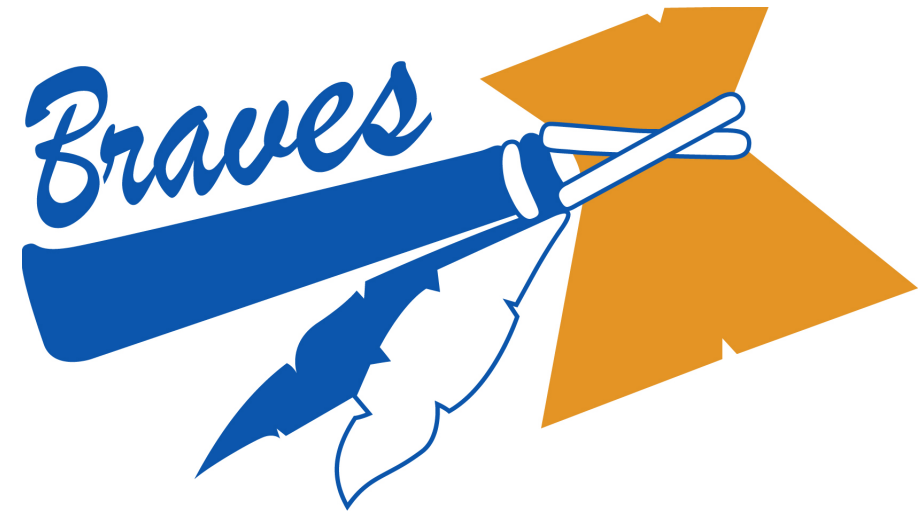
- Mukwonago Football Golf Outing

 - Recipient is someone who works hard, has excellent grades, is coachable, and is a great community servant



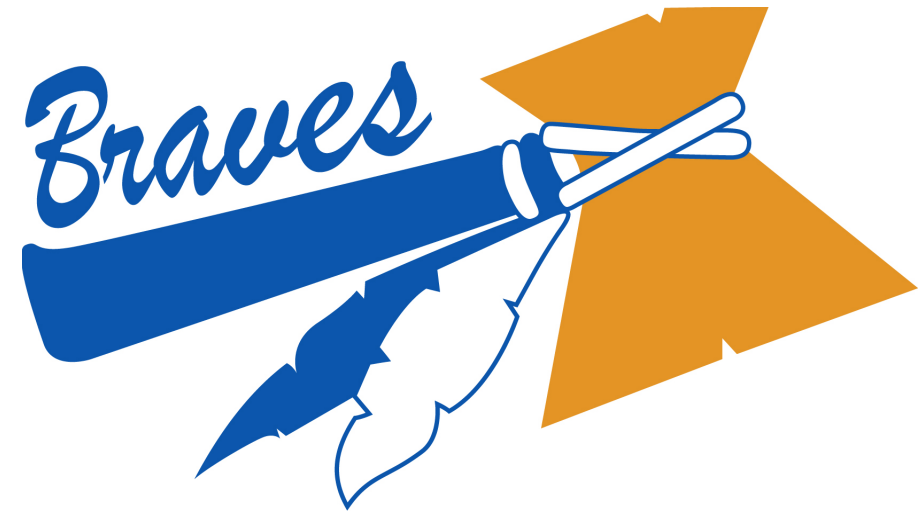
Summer Camp Days
