### RECREATION REPORT

- Kerr an update on Adult Co-Ed Volleyball League which ended on Wednesday, November 15

- Kerr provided an update on Youth Indoor Soccer. Registration is now closed and had a total of 135 participants.

- Kerr provided an update Spring Soccer. Kerr let the board know that we'll now have 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Gr. register with DASC. They'll still form Tea teams, like we've done in the past. The reason for this is it will be easier for communication with DASC to communicate with parents and coaches. Tea Parks & Rec. will still help the coaches with practices and equipment.

- Kerr provided an update on Volleyball Skills Camp. Currently we're in search of trying to find someone who would want to oversee running the program since Eric Thiel is no longer the Tea Volleyball Head coach, and the other coaches don't currently want to take over the program.

- Kerr provided an update on Tea Parks and Rec. Sponsorships.

- Kerr provided an update on Morning Summer Rec. Programs. Kerr asked the board what the best instructor to participant ratio would be. The consent from the board is 1:6 for 1<sup>st</sup>-2<sup>nd</sup> grade, and 1:8 for 3<sup>rd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> Grade and 5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Grade.
