

NOCO ICE CENTER PROTOCOLS- Spring 2021 – Updated April 6, 2021

- **3 spectators per player**
- **Spectators will be required to sign in and provide contact information- Per Larimer County Health Department**
 - **Spectators must wear a mask entire time while in NoCo Ice Center. Anyone over the age of 10 must wear a mask at all times.**

Spectators will be permitted to enter game Five to ten (5-10) min before start of game. As soon as game is over parents need to leave the building through the east door. Do NOT wait in the lobby before or after the game.

- **Teams/Players should not arrive more than thirty (30) minutes prior to game time.**
 - **Players and Coaches are required to wear masks throughout the facility. While entering, dressing, on ice, exiting. Coaches/Scorekeepers/penalty box people will be required to wear masks entire time. This includes coaches while on the bench. Per the Larimer County Health Department- Anyone over the age of 10 must wear a mask at all times.**

- **There will be no handshake line following the game.**
- **Teams will have twenty (20) minutes to exit the locker room / facility following their game, so NoCo staff has time to clean and disinfect prior to the arrival of the next teams.**
- **Players must have their own water bottle clearly identified with their name on it.**
- **Players should screen self for covid symptoms before the game and if are feeling sick should not attend game.**
- **NoCo Ice Center has Livebarn.**
- **Noco reserves the right to stop game play if these rules aren't followed.**
