

WYBL Covid-19 Guidelines - 2020/2021 Season

I. Prior to Arrival.

1. Common Sense. Strive to be an agent of positive change in the fight against Covid-19. It is much better for everyone if you err on the side of caution. All spectators, coaches, players, staff, officials, etc must perform a self-screening for symptoms that are related to Covid-19. If an individual answers "yes" to either of the self-screening points below, they must not attend WYBL sponsored events and should contact their healthcare provider.
2. Self-Screening Requirements.
 1. In the last 13 days, have you tested positive for Covid-19 or been in close contact with a suspected or confirmed case of Covid-19?
 2. In the last 24 hours, have you experienced any of these symptoms that are not normal to you? Cough, diarrhea, body aches, fatigue, a 100.3 degree temperature or greater, headaches, nausea/vomiting, loss of taste or smell, difficult breathing or a sore throat?

II. Arrival at Hosting Facility.

1. Time. 25 minutes before your scheduled game time you will be allowed into the hosting school facility.
 1. The player and his approved spectator(s) must check in together.
2. Facility Entry Point.
 1. Each hosting school will have one designated entry point and all players, coaches, referees, and spectators must use that entrance.
 2. For games at Center Court (Waukesha), you must enter at the back door only (through the sand volleyball area).
 3. Temperature Scan. The WYBL has purchased several temperature scanning devices and upon entry, you will have your temperature scanned. A reading of 100.3 or greater will be grounds to deny you admission.
 4. Masks are required in the hosting facility.
 5. Our capacity limitation is 30 persons per team. This number includes players, coaches and spectators associated with that team.
 1. A game day roster will be printed and at the entry desk. Each person will be checked off as well as their associated spectators (two per player).
 2. This document will satisfy our contact tracing required by most hosting schools.
 6. There will be a \$3 fee charged per spectator.
 1. No ATM access in schools. Parents are encouraged to bring exact change, though not a requirement.
 2. All players and TWO coaches will be admitted free of charge. While a team may nominally have more coaches helping out, only TWO will be allowed in free and ALLOWED on the bench.
3. Designated Team Staging Areas.(high schools)
 1. Each team and spectators will be designated a socially distanced area to assemble, change shoes, and hear instructions from the coaching staff (while other games are in progress).
 2. Teams will be escorted to the designated court by a WYBL or host facility representative once the previous game is completed and the court has been cleared/approved.
4. Designated Team Staging Areas (Center Court).
 1. There will not be a designated staging area. Teams are asked to socially distance while awaiting their game to start. We will continually work with Center Court staff to identify "safe" areas for pre-game staging.

III. Facility Guidelines & Support

1. Each facility will have a designated traffic pattern. These will include which door to enter, staging areas, restrooms, and exit information.
2. Locker Rooms will NOT be available.
3. Restrooms will be OPEN. Please remind everyone the importance of thorough hand washing after restroom use.

4. Concessions will NOT be offered by hosting schools. *You will be allowed to carry in food & drink as needed.*
5. Concessions WILL BE offered at Center Court. *For games at CC, no carry in food or beverage is allowed.* Masks may be removed to actively eat or drink.
6. First Aid. There will NOT be access to the facilities trainer's room. It is the responsibility of each team to bring a basic first aid kit to include bandages, ice packs, etc.
7. All facility signs and instructions must be followed without exceptions.

IV. Game Procedures.

1. Masks are required by all persons in the facility until further notice. Everybody means EVERYBODY. We will relax this requirement when the schools that host us say it is appropriate to do so. Players obviously may remove their masks to properly hydrate, but should immediately put their mask back on after drinking.
2. Masks are NOT currently required for players that have games scheduled for Center Court. This may change as circumstances change. Either way, masks are required for all others at Center Court's facility.
3. There should be no shared materials on the bench (ie: water bottles, towels, etc)
4. No concessions will be offered by the schools. It is the responsibility of each participant to bring a water bottle (re-fill available at selected school stations) or a hydrating sports drink of their choosing.
5. Concessions WILL be offered at Center Court as noted above.
6. The Game Schedule at hosting schools will be back-to-back in 99% of the instances. 4-5 minutes between games may be used for additional practice or as a rest period.
7. The Game Schedule at Center Court is our traditional play-sit-play format. We highly suggest social distancing (with masks) in between games.
8. Completion of the Game. Exhibit sportsmanship by waving or acknowledging the other team from a distance.
 1. There will be no handshake line, fist bumps, or crossing of the teams for any reason.
 2. Players and coaches must pick up all used supplies, secure their gear, and depart the bench area. NO post game speeches in the bench area!
9. Players, coaches, and spectators will then exit the hosting facility and follow the designated sign/route. A WYBL or hosting staffer may assist where needed.
