Registration Information & Details

1. Review this packet for details regarding the pre-season camp options, program details, fees, NIHL tryout and NWHL evaluation times, and other information. All registrations must be completed online prior to tryouts or evaluations.
2. Go to www.usahockeyregistration.com and register your player for the 2020-2021 Season or look up your confirmation number if you registered on or after April 1, 2020. You must provide your confirmation number during the online registration process. Registration with USA Hockey is required for all hockey players 10U and older in the United States. If you registered with USA Hockey on or after April 1, 2020, your registration is still valid for this fall's season.
3. Go to www.admiralshockeyclub.com and register your player for the program of your choice using the appropriate registration link.

 1. Players at the youth 10U through 18U level and girls 10U through 19U should register for 3S pre-season camps and tryouts/evaluations or camps with the [2020-21 Step 1 Registration for Camps and Tryouts/Evaluations link](#).
 2. Step 2 must also be completed by September 15, 2020. Complete [2020-21 Step 2 Team Fee Payment Options](#) to make team fee payments in full or establish your payment plan for this season's team fees. Do not complete Step 2 until you have registered for camps and tryouts/evaluations and camps using the Step 1 registration link.

The Admirals Hockey Club prides itself on the development of our players. We focus on the development of players at all skill levels and ages, utilizing the principles of USA Hockey's ADM (American Development Model) and LTAD (Long Term Athlete Development). These principles serve as the foundation to help each player realize their maximum potential in the game of hockey. This approach requires a commitment to not just the training of our players, but to our coaches as well. Our Executive Hockey Director, former NHL Player & AAA Coach, Alain Lemieux, along with our Head Coaches bring a high level of skill, passion, commitment and experience to their roles and have dedicated themselves to the development of excellence in both our players and our coaches. At the Admirals Hockey Club, your children will receive the highest caliber training, correct practice to game ratios, and age-appropriate practice concepts and skills. They will develop, compete and have fun playing the greatest game in the world.

This fall season the Admirals will field competitive teams in the Chicago United Hockey League (CUHL), Northern Illinois Hockey League (NIHL) and Northwest Hockey League (NWHL). We are excited to offer CUHL teams at the 8U Mite level only. We offer NIHL teams at 10U, 12U, 14U, 16U/18U and Girls. We offer NWHL teams at 10U, 12U, and 14U level. We also offer our Future Admirals programming for those beginner skaters. NIHL teams will be selected on a try-out basis, not all players who try out will make a team. If a player chooses to try out for NIHL and is not selected for a team, they will be given the option to play on a NWHL team. NWHL teams will be selected based upon a player evaluation. Teams are all subject to participation and availability and we encourage early registration to ensure a spot for your player.

Which program is right for my player?



Elite AA-A level travel (Squirt-Midget & Girls)

Players will participate in a tryout process. Player selection will occur at this time. Our Hockey director and head coaches evaluate players based on the following criteria: skating, puck control, physical ability, shot strength, play making ability, sense of the game, work ethic and coach-ability. Each coach may weigh these differently based on coaching philosophy and/or team needs. Players are given a rating by all evaluators. The highest rated players are selected for the first team, then the second team, etc. In the NIHL league, player positions and ice times will vary and are at the discretion of the coaching staff. NIHL is a competitive travel league. The season can have up to 40 games, tournaments and might require out of state travel.



B-level (Squirt-Midget)

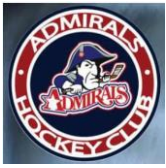
Players will participate in an evaluation during which the hockey directors and head coaches will evaluate players based on the following criteria: skating, puck control, physical ability, shot strength, play making ability, work ethic and coach-ability. Coaches may weigh these differently based on their coaching philosophy. After the last session of evaluations, players will be placed on a team. Players are assigned a ranking, and balanced teams are formed. In NWHL league, players are given balanced and equal ice time. Players registered for B-level NWHL do not need to attend to A-level tryouts unless they are interested in playing on a NIHL Team.



8U Mite (CUHL Junior Admirals)

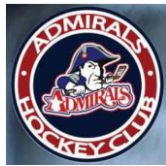
New for the fall 2020-2021 season, the Admirals will have CUHL league teams at the 8U Mite level. Players will participate in an evaluation during which the head coaches will evaluate players based on the following criteria: skating, puck control, physical ability, shot strength, play making ability, work ethic and coach-ability. Each coach may weigh these differently based on coaching philosophy and/or team needs. Players are given a ranking by all evaluators. The highest rated player are selected for the first team, then the second, etc.

CUHL is a mite only league governed by the AAU (Amateur Athletic Union) and is not affiliated with USA hockey. CUHL typically has 90+ teams in four divisions, each with several tiers, ensuring parity and appropriate competition. Depending on team placement, the season can have up to 24 games plus playoffs, and may require out of state travel. The CUHL season runs September – February.



Future Admirals Pre-Hockey – Level 1 (all ages)

Pre-Hockey is structured so your child will have the opportunity to learn the basics of hockey from experienced professional instructors in an atmosphere that is relaxed, non-competitive and fun. No hockey experience is needed. Classes concentrate on skating basics and confidence building. Our program prides itself on the quality of the coaching staff. We make it a priority to train our coaches to ensure your child receives the best instruction available. Your skater will learn advanced skating techniques, passing, stick handling and shooting in order to prepare them for the game of hockey. Upon completion of our program, we aim to have your child prepared to join a team. Evaluation will take place on the final class to determine if your child should return or move up to our In House program. Pre-Hockey is designed for skaters who are looking to learn hockey skills in preparation for joining a team.



Future Admirals In House 8 & Under – Level 2 (2012 & younger)

Players born from 1/1/2012 & younger are invited to join the best developmental hockey league in the state. We following the USA Hockey Athletic Development Model (ADM) to provide the best possible experience for your up and coming hockey player. At ages 5-8 years old, our objective for physical development is to refine fundamental movement skills and begin to acquire basic sports skills. This is the time when the foundation is laid for future acquisition of more advanced skills. As far as psychological development goes, we will be focusing on providing FUN, motivating practices and games, developing reasoning skills through unstructured competition, building confidence by creating competitive groups, which will allow for a high rate of success and promoting individual and group participation as well as introducing the participants to simple rules and sports ethics (fair play). The In-House program will meet for skills, practices, and half-ice games. We will attempt to team up with other local organizations for Jamborees and practice games. All players who register will be placed on a team – there are no cuts.



Future Admirals In House 9 & Older – Level 2 (2011 & older)

The Future Admirals In-House League is a developmental league for players birth years 2011 & older. We will have weekly skills, practices, and half-ice games. The focus will be on providing FUN, motivating practices and game, developing reasoning skills through unstructured competition and building confidence by creating competitive groups. This program assists our beginning hockey players to develop their skills with players who are of similar age, size, and ability. All players who register will participate in a session evaluation and be placed on a team – there are no cuts.

Uniform Standards & Ordering Information

**Club uniform is mandatory for all players in CUHL, NIHL & NWHL.
Future Admirals Pre-Hockey will receive a jersey, which is included in the registration fees.**



JERSEY:

- Jerseys for all 8U through 18U and Girls are \$200 for a set of home and away jerseys. Players who do not own a set of jerseys will be required to purchase a set. It is highly recommended that players in need of new or replacement jerseys attend a sizing session, with shoulder pads, so that the correct size jersey can be determined. All jerseys come with the name and a number. There will be no refunds on these personalized jerseys. All payments must be made at the time of ordering.
- Future Admirals Pre-hockey players will be provided one jersey and one pair of game socks. The jersey number will be assigned. Uniform orders and sizing will not be available. No number requests will be taken.
- Future Admirals In House players will be provided 1 pair of socks. If you are new to In-house or returning but need a new jersey, they are \$36 + tax.
- Current Admirals players whose birth year is 2012 and older will be able to retain their current jersey number if possible. For those players birth year 2013 and younger and/or are new to the Admirals Hockey Club will be assigned a number based on their birth year. Odd birth years will be given an odd number and even birth years an even number. Number requests within this birth year policy will be taken into consideration; however, Admirals reserve the right to assign available numbers.

PANTS/SHELLS:

- Navy blue pants or navy blue shells are required for the 2020-2021 season for all CUHL, NIHL and NWHL players. Future Admirals Pre-Hockey and In-House players are not required to have navy blue. Shells are available for purchase at any hockey store such as Jerry's or Pure Hockey. Should your child need new hockey pants we would recommend purchasing a navy blue pair.

HELMETS:

- White helmets are encouraged, but not required. Should your child need a new helmet, we suggest purchasing a white one.

WARM UP:

- Warm ups are required for all CUHL, NIHL and NWHL players. For new players or those in need of replacement warm ups they can be ordered during the established sizing/ordering dates. As with the jerseys, sample warm-ups will be available for sizing purposes only and it is highly recommended that you attend a sizing session, so you may order your correct size warm-up jacket or pants. All jackets come with the player's name. There will be no refunds on these personalized warm-ups. All payments must be made at the time of ordering.
- Warm up prices are as follows:
 - Lightweight jacket - \$70 plus tax
 - Pants - \$42 plus tax
 - Midweight jackets - \$80 plus tax
 - Heavyweight jackets - \$100 plus tax



Uniform Standards & Ordering Information Cont'd

PRACTICE JERSEY:

- Practice jerseys for all 8U through 18U players are \$36 (plus tax). Players who already have a current practice jersey that still fits are not required to purchase a new practice jersey. Players who are new to the club or do not own a practice jersey are required to purchase one. Random numbers will be assigned. Practice jerseys can be ordered during the established sizing/ordering dates. All payments must be made at the time of ordering.

SOCKS:

- Two pairs of game socks are included in the team fees for all 8U through 18U players. Sample socks will be available for sizing purposes only and it is highly recommended that you attend a sizing session, so you may order your correct size socks.
- One pair of game socks is included in the team fee for Future Admirals Pre-hockey & In House players. Players do not need to be sized or place an order for their socks.

Uniform fitting guidelines (no exceptions):

- Players must be fitted **BEFORE** they skate/practice.
- Players must have their shoulder pads on to size jersey properly.
- Players must have a face mask on while being fitted.
- Vendor will accept debit card or credit card only.

Northern Illinois Hockey League (NIHL)

The Admirals participate in the Tier II Northern Illinois Hockey League (NIHL) for Travel AA/A teams. Players are selected on a best player; best team basis and individual player ice time is earned and potentially not balanced. This fall season the Admirals will field competitive teams in the GIRLS Northern Illinois Hockey League (NIHL). We will be offering NIHL teams at **10U, 12U, 14U, 16U and 19U**. Teams are all subject to participation and availability and we encourage early registration to ensure a spot for your player. Girls can be double rostered if they want to play on both a youth NIHL team and a girls' team. Any player that would like to double roster must try out for both teams. Players that are selected for both a youth NIHL team and a girls' team must give their 1st priority to their youth NIHL team.

Players selected for a CUHL team must be registered with AAU. Tryouts will be held at Center Ice.

Financial Overview & Policies

Registration & Payments

- All players for all programs require online registration prior to participation.
- Families with past due balances from previous seasons will not be able to register or attend the new season tryout, practices or games until the past due balance is paid in full.
- The fee for the 3S Pre-Season Camp is non-refundable and must be paid in full via credit or debit card prior to the first camp session. Any questions regarding payments please email Mike Widicus at Treasurer@admiralshockeyclub.com.
- A non-refundable tryout fee is required for all 8U CUHL, 10U NIHL, 12U NIHL, 14U NIHL, and 16U/18U NIHL. If a player is not selected for any NIHL team at their age level, the tryout fee can be applied as a deposit for playing on a NWHL team (excluding the 8U and 16/18U age level) if they choose to accept a spot on the NWHL roster. If a player registers for tryouts but does not attend tryouts the tryout fee is non-refundable and non-transferable. If a player attends tryouts and is selected for a CUHL or NIHL team but chooses not to play on that team, the tryout fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.
- A non-refundable deposit is required for all 10U NWHL, 12U NWHL, and 14U NWHL. This non-refundable deposit is applied toward the total season fees and must be paid online prior to the first evaluation. If a player does not attend evaluations and/or is selected for a team but chooses not to play on that team, the deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable.
- Payments for all team fees are made IN FULL or via a PAYMENT PLAN with up to four monthly payments. Payment plans must be set up by utilizing the Step 2 link after you have registered your player. After teams are formed, a reminder with the payment link for team fees will be sent to the email address used at registration. With this team fees link, or within Step 2, you must either pay your fees in full via credit or debit card, or you must set up your payment plan with a credit or debit card. **The first payment or payment in full is due by September 15, 2020.** The payment plan can include up to four monthly installments on September 15, October 15, November 15 and December 15, 2020. If you use a payment plan there is a \$100 processing fee that will be added to your first payment. There is no additional charge for paying via credit card. No cash or checks will be accepted for team fee payments. Any questions regarding payments please email Mike Widicus at Treasurer@admiralshockeyclub.com.
- Failure to comply with the fee agreement will result in immediate suspension from all Admirals Hockey Club privileges and activities. **Accounts must remain current or players will not be allowed to participate in any on- or off-ice practices, games, or team activities.**
- Declined payments will require a remedy of full payment of the installment and an additional \$50 service fee.

Discounts / Fee Reduction Opportunities

- Early registration discounts are available through August 7, 2020, for youth 8U through 14U players and girls U10 through 19U players. Register & pay on line for **BOTH** the tryout/evaluation fee and the 3S camp fee on or before August 7, 2020.

- Goalie Discount: Full-time goalies at the 8U, 10U, 12U, 14U, 16U/18U age levels **with their own equipment** receive 40% off published fees.

Admirals Raffle

All CUHL/NIHL/NWHL age level players through 16/18U level will be required to purchase 20 tickets at a total cost of \$200.00. For those families with multiple players, the raffle ticket purchase will be required for the oldest child only. The raffle ticket obligation of \$200 per family is an additional fee within the registration. Payment for raffle tickets is included with the first installment payment and must be paid before players will be added to team rosters. Families can (1) sell the tickets at face value (\$10 each) and keep the proceeds; or (2) enter the tickets in to the raffle on their own behalf, effectively buying the tickets themselves.

Tournaments, Travel & Slush

- The Admirals Hockey Club participates in tournaments locally, out of state and internationally (Canada) per the coaches discretion. Your child will be required to have a passport if their team is traveling to Canada for a tournament.
- All travel expenses are an additional cost to consider. Most tournaments are “stay to play”, which means the host of the tournament contracts hotels & rates to secure enough rooms for all teams participating. Each player will be required to book a room at the designated hotel at the rate predetermined by the tournament host. This requirement does not apply to tournaments local to our home rink, Center Ice of DuPage.
- A slush fund is a monetary fund established at the beginning of the season by the team manager. The amount will be determined by the manager and head coach based on the number of local and out-of-state tournaments the team shall attend and to cover team expenses that are not covered by a player's season fees. Included, but not limited, in the slush fund amount shall be tournament entry fees, referee and ice fees for scrimmages, entry fees for Blackhawk Cup (Illinois State Tournament) round robin, if applicable, team parties, coach's lodging for out-of-town league games and/or tournaments where a free coach's room is not available or attainable and coach's gifts. Each player shall be responsible for the payment of their proportionate share of the slush fund within the time frame established by the manager. On average, slush can range between \$400-\$550 per player.
