The FWAHA was formed in April 2017. All Travel and Select teams began playing as the PSM Force through a sponsorship by Parkview Sports Medicine. There were many firsts - High School Hockey Media Night; Sponsor Night; and a Parents night where families received an overview of the first year and a look ahead.

● 2018-2019

The FWAHA welcomes twenty-one total teams, including the first Girls team, the PSM LadyForce 16U team, as well as adding JV teams in the High School league. For the first year, all Travel and Select teams are training with the Parkview Sports Medicine Performance team including off-ice dryland and nutrition training. Additionally, all PSM Force Travel teams joined the Little Caesar's Amateur Hockey League with the SportONE/Parkivew Icehouse as their home ice.
