2018-2019 UWHL Secretary's Report

The UWHL had three Conferences – Red, White, and Blue. No new teams entered the Red Conference for the 2018-2019 season. Four teams entered the White Conference for the 2018-2019 season; the Jaguars entered a team in the White Conference, the Quarry Cats moved from the Blue Conference to the White Conference, the Americans Valor moved from the Red Conference to the White Conference, and the Hawks Red moved from the Red Conference to the White Conference, renaming themselves Hawks Black. The Black Widows moved from the White Conference to the Blue Conference for the 2018-2019 season.

2018-2019 UWHL Treasurer's Report

The UWHL bank account as of season end has a balance of \$17,441.52 which is an increase of \$378.54 versus the end of last season. This reflects an increase in revenue versus expenses over the length of the season. Non profit corporations are generally advised to carry at least 3 years operating expenses in reserve (to make sure the corporation can thrive even if there was a change to revenue). Our current season expenses average about \$22,000 on per season (over the last 6 seasons), and our bank balance therefore represents less than one season of expenses. The goal of

the corporation each season is to come as close to \$0 as possible when balancing revenue and expenses.

Items with the greatest impact financially for the organization this season were a greater number of Classic Game buyouts (+\$1,155.00 year over year), partially balanced by a decrease in Classic Game Tickets sold (-\$663.00). UWHL t-shirts/sweatshirts sold were 34% lower than last season (-\$909.00 year over year).

Recurring expenses for this season included \$2,129.00 in website costs (\$2,000 is paid bi-annually to Sport Engine), and \$70.00 in corporate tax fees owed to the State of Delaware.

2018-2019 Season Player Notes:

Three Request for Player Reviews were received, all for players in the White Conference. A Roster Committee was unable to be formed for any of the reviews due to personnel availability. The UWHL President was able to witness a game for one of the players and deemed the player appropriate for the White Conference. Two of the requests were received late in the season and the UWHL President was not able to witness any games. The two players were reviewed during a play-off game and deemed appropriate for the White Conference. The difficulty in forming a Roster Review Committee during the season prompted a proposed change to the PPG.

Playoffs Results and Report

Playoffs were held March 23-24, 2019 at Hatfield. This is the third year we held our playoffs at Hatfield. The rink provided scorekeepers as they have in previous years. Everything ran smoothly aside from a missing scorekeeper on Sunday. Members of the Executive Committee were able to score keep during the absence and the rink was notified.

The 2018 playoffs featured the annual league party, catered by the café at Hatfield. PhilMar Photography continued their ongoing relationship with the UWHL by taking photos of many of the playoff games and providing prints to the championship teams.

We enacted the rule that there must be at least 1 UWHL officer present at all times to oversee the check in table, games and to present awards and that this officer must not be participating in games while overseeing. This helped keep everything much more organized.

The UWHL Referee in Chief oversaw scheduling referees for playoffs. The majority of the playoff games were officiated by female referees.

There was only 1 Championship in the Red Division. the Freeze beat the Mighty Moose 2-1 and the Reapers beat the Bobcats 3-2. The Reapers played the Freeze in the Championship and won 2-1.

In White A Division, the Flames beat the Freeze 6-4 and Queenston beat the Quarry Cats 2-0. Queenston played the Flames in Championship and won 6-5.

In White B Division, the Hawks White beat the Senators 5-0 and the Predators beat the Hawks Black 4-1. The Predators played the Hawks White in Championship and won 3-2.

In Blue A Division, the Jaguars beat the Patriots 8-1 and the Phoenix beat the Freeze 2-0. The Jaguars played the Phoenix in Championship and won 3-2.

In the Blue B Division, the Thrashers beat the Bobcats 6-0 and the Voodoo beat the Black Widows 2-0. The Voodoo played the Thrashers in Championship and won 1-0.

2019 UWHL Winter Classic Event

The UWHL Winter Classic event was held at the PPL Center in Allentown, PA on Saturday, January 12th, 2019. The PPL Center is home to the AHL Lehigh Valley Phantoms (AHL team of the Philadelphia Flyers), and we have held our annual event here for the past several years. Thirteen (13) teams participated in the event sending 4 skaters each, and played in 2 games divided by skill level, with Blue/White and White/Red games (determined based on team slotting in the league) played in the early afternoon. Each skater received a UWHL t-shirt for participating in the game. The games were 1 hour slots with 12-minute stop-clock periods and time for warm-ups and photos, with 2 referees. Tickets for the Phantoms game in the evening were sold at \$23 each, with each team required to purchase a minimum of 14 tickets. Teams not participating in the event (13 teams) paid the \$145 buyout fee. The Reapers Red team sold the greatest numbers of tickets with 33 tickets. The Treasurer's Report reflects full profit and expenses for the event.

Website Report

The website was renewed this year for an additional two years of use through SportNgin. Two years remain in the subscription. Technical difficulties were encountered when loading the play-off brackets since different divisions are used for play-offs (A and B pools). SportNgin technical support was called to assist.
