General Tournament Information

The tournament will be held at Appleton East High School (2121 Emmers Drive) in both the Patriot Gym and the New Gym. Parking is available in the Schaefer St. parking lot as well as John Street.

Each team is guaranteed 3 games. Teams will play each other as laid out in the Bracket Team app. We will also have printed brackets hanging outside of the Patriot gym. These will be considered the official brackets in the event the app is not working properly

Rules & Related information

WIAA Officials and rules will be utilized, except as noted below.

All games will consist of two 18-minute halves with a **continuous clock until the last minute of each half** .

Halftime will be 3 minutes.

Overtime will be **2** minutes, with the clock stopped during dead ball situations. 2nd OT is sudden death unless it's the Championship game/3rd round.

Pressing is allowed in the last two minutes of each half, however, no pressing is allowed if a team is leading by 15 points or more. Zone defenses are not allowed. Teams may zone press full court, but you must fall back to man-to-man defense in the ½ court.

There will be **3 timeouts** allowed per team per game, and 1 per team per overtime period.

All technical fouls will result in an automatic 2 points and possession of the ball awarded to the other team.

Each team must provide the scorer's table with an official roster before each game.

All reasonable attempts will be made to keep the tournament on schedule. A pre-game timer lasting at least 3 minutes will be run to advise teams of the intended start time. If a team is not on the playing floor within 5 minutes after this start time, that team will automatically forfeit the game.

Unsportsmanlike conduct by players, coaches, and fans will not be tolerated.

Teams must wear their own matching shirts with numbers on the uniform. Please bring your own basketballs, towels and medical supplies.

Official's decisions are final, with no protests allowed.

There will be an entry fee for all spectators, starting with school-aged children.

Concessions will be provided. Please, no carry-ins.
