### **Financial Update:**

- Revenue of \$6K for May, split with concession and sponsorships that you came through.
- \$12K for uniforms, which was under budget.
- Suggestion of Junior Ump program to start in the fall.
- Tournament fees are paid, except for 8U
- Concession stand is up \$1700 profit, which is \$400 more than last year.
- Considering a \$1 fee for all venmo transactions at the concession stands.
- Light on field supplies.

**Motion presented by Colin Rafter to donate \$250 to the LV softball for gratitude for the funds generated through concessions during their weekend tournament. Seconded by Kevin Daily. Motion passes unanimously.**

### **Rec Update:**

- Good feedback from Board members about rec. All levels represented.
- Pictures almost all distributed to teams.

- Ordering medals for Rookies and T-Ball kids.
- Trophies go to winners and runners-up at minors and majors levels.
- Playoff dates being worked on with coaches for minors and majors.

**Concession Stand:**

- Slightly ahead from last year at this time, by about \$400.
- Sign up genius has been consistent and efficient, about 98% are showing up.
- Jacob suggested a separate sign up genius for board members on Saturdays to work the grill.
- Discussion of 'bond checks' for those that don't volunteer. Would consider, but need to work out details and see if it could be done in Sports Engine.
- Next year, three things:
  - Buy a popcorn machine
  - Buy a cotton candy machine
  - Increase the cost of candy
  - TABLE UNTIL SEPTEMBER
- Parents asking to purchase Long Valley apparel. Mostly rec hats.

**Travel Update:**

- All teams are registered for second tournament.
- Proposal to have a travel tryout date announced prior to the end of the spring season.
- If interested in fielding a fall travel team, coaches should start gauging interest and recruiting now.
