KANSAS SRC CONCUSSION POLICY

If it appears, in even the slightest case, that a player or players may have sustained some type of a possible head injury, stop the game immediately, beckon on the coach or medical staff if available to attend to the player(s), and follow USSF protocol on having the player(s) go to the sidelines before they can return. The one exception is for the goalkeeper who does not have to leave the field of play. Certainly, in every case, tell the coach there may be a possible head injury, then remove yourself from the area of the injury and let the coach/trainer attend to the player.

YOU MUST ERR ON THE POSSIBILITY THAT THERE MAY BE HEAD TRAUMA RATHER THAN NOT DOING ANYTHING. DO NOT WAIT FOR THE BALL TO LEAVE THE FIELD PRIOR TO TAKING ACTION. YOU ARE NOT AN EXPERT SO DO NOT ASK IF THE PLAYER IS OK AND THEN PROCEED WITH PLAY. GET THE COACH/TRAINER ON THE FIELD IN EVERY INSTANCE.
