** Minnesota WINTER Weather **

The Minnesota Weather Factor

Predicting Minnesota winter weather can be hard. In order to have a clear and consistent plan for cancelling winter sessions we have created a winter weather cancellation guide:

Winter Session Cancellation Guide

We will only consider CANCELLING winter sessions IF:

- Facilities are closed.
- An active weather system has prompted MNDOT to issue "No Travel" advisory (different than a general MNDOT "travel advisory.")

Excessive cold or wind ("10-20-30" rule):

2.5 hours ahead of a session, we will check to see IF:

- Temperatures are decreasing AND will exceed ten below zero (-10°) for sessions starting before 5:00 PM or;
- Temperatures are decreasing and will exceed twenty below zero (-20°) for sessions starting after 5:00 PM.
- Anytime temperatures are decreasing and "feels like" (see "[windchill](#)" calculator) temperatures exceed thirty below zero (-30°).

Forecasts:

- Only large approaching systems that have consistently delivered dangerous travel conditions (rain/ice or heavy snow) will be considered. We will not try to predict systems or snowfall amounts.

TeamSnap Notifications

- We will send cancellation notices though TeamSnap at least 2-hours ahead of scheduled session(s). IF weather changes suddenly less than the two-hour window allows, we will still send alerts to members.

Session Attendance

- As always, if anyone does not feel safe traveling, DO NOT come! Safety is priority!
- Just know, we DO NOT cancel sessions if "only 9, 8, 7..." players are attending. We serve anyone and everyone that shows up, regardless of how many players attend (or are planning to attend) a training session.
