# Season Information

- There will be 3 teams. 2 teams with 9 players, 1 team with 8 players. First new player will be added to the team with 8 players. Each team will play the other 2 teams 4 times for a total of 8 games each team.
- Practice will start on Aug 5th and will be arranged by the coach of the team with Jorge Villasenor.
- Games will start on Aug 24th and will predominantly be played on Saturday's at Garin Park, 230 Lawrence Lane Brentwood. Weekday and Sunday games might be necessary. We will do our best to limit those occurrences.
- Game day materials will be set up by the first games home team and taken down by the away teams in the final game of the day. Keys will be distributed to the coaches.

# Season Information Cont.

- Uniforms (jersey and shorts) will be distributed to the coach
- A ball will be provided for each player
- Each coach will receive some practice bibs and cones
- Each player is required to have socks, shin guards, and cleats
- Please take proper care of the equipment and store/lock it up properly





# U10 Playing Rules



- Teams will play 7v7 including the goal keeper
- Game length is 2 25 minute halves
- One referee will officiate the game
- Field Size: Minimum 35yd x 55yd Maximum 45yd x 65yd
- Scores and standings are kept on the Club website.

- No heading, punting, or slide tackling allowed
- Goal size: Minimum 6'x18', Maximum 7'x21'
- Substitutions on any stoppage



# U10 Playing Rules Cont.

- We will again use the build out line (opposing team must be behind the line on goal kicks or when the goal keeper has the ball in their hands). This is to encourage teams to possess the ball from the back line going forward
- The new FIFA rule is that the ball does not need to clear the penalty area (box) on goal kicks.
- Mercy Rule
- Game should not get too lopsided as this is not keeping with the spirit of play of our Recreational program. For our Recreational programs, once a team goes behind by 3 goals, they are allowed to introduce an additional player onto the field, i.e. 7v8, 7v9, etc.
- Any team that outscores their opponent by more than 5 goals will only receive 2 points for the win instead of 3
- Our goal is to create an environment where the players do not want the season to end due to the enjoyment they get from the game. Let's provide a positive training and game environment and best of luck in the season ahead!
