## *Parent's Code of Conduct*

St Isaac Jogues Charger Athletics believes parents play a vital role in the development of student-athletes.

I will encourage good sportsmanship by being a positive role model.

I will try my best to make athletics a positive experience for everyone involved, i.e., participants, coaches, officials, and spectators. Always remember that kids participate in sport for their enjoyment, not yours.

I will insist my player treat other players, coaches, officials, and fans with respect.

I will reinforce the school's drug and alcohol-free policies and refrain from use alcohol and other drugs before or during contests.

I will do my best to understand and appreciate the rules of the contest.

I will show appreciation for an outstanding play by either team.

I will be a "team" fan, not a "my child" fan.

I will help my child learn that success is measured by the development of skills, not winning, or losing. Never make negative comments to a child for making a mistake or losing a competition.

If I have a concern, I will talk to the coach at the appropriate time and place, i.e., never, during, or immediately after a contest.

I will do my best to remember my admittance to a school athletic event provides me with the privilege of observing the contest, not berating officials, coaches, or players.

I will always respect the official's decisions and teach kids to do likewise.

I will always show appreciation for volunteer sports coaches, officials, and club administrators.

I will wait twenty-four hours to address all disputes, concerns, questions, issues, and comments in the following order: Coach, Athletic Director and then Pastor. Communication must begin with the Coach. Proceed to the Athletic Director if the situation is not resolved. If still not satisfied, you may proceed to the Pastor. Provide ample time for the conflict to be resolved. Failure to go in this order will result in concern not being addressed.

The pastor of a parish has the final authority in all aspects concerning athletics. Should the pastor be required to make a decision, that decision will be final and without recourse to any other organization.
