Girls Soccer Wins Regional Title

Girls Soccer beat rival Glenbrook North 3-0 to win the Regional title.

With the win, the Titans record improves to 20-3-2!

Stadler's goal was her 30th of the year but South coach Mark Daniels values his Villanova-bound senior beyond her scoring.

"Besides her goal-scoring ability, it's her ability to assist her teammates and just be a team player," Coach Mark Daniels told the

Glenview Lantern. "She could score fifty goals if she wanted to but she looks to service the ball and looks for teammates, but when she wants to go to goal, she can. She's obviously a go-to player and we'll miss her next year."

Weiss, Stadler and Challen Flaws have helped spearhead the Titans' attack, and the defense is finally nearly injury-free for the first time all season.

"We missed Kate Sullivan for twelve games and everyone has missed games," Daniels said. "Katie Gates and Christie Chrones have been solid, Marilee (Hague) subbed in for Kate, and Grace O'Brien has been rock-steady in the back. She may be the only player who played every game in the back for us."

The team beat Maine East 7-0 in the semis. The Titans Face Evanston the sectional semifinal Tuesday night.

Girls Track & Field at State Championships

The jumping and Running Titans went to state this weekend. The team had four qualifiers in 5 events.

Lauren Yim qualified in the wheelchair 100M, Taylor Ozimek qualified in High Jump with a Sectional victory jump of 5'3", Sydney Willits qualified in the Long Jump and Triple Jump, and Raelyn Roberson qualified in the Long Jump with a sectional victory jump of 18'8".

Taylor jumped well at state and had one of the best four-year track careers in GBS history. Taylor exudes what it mean to be a Titan in victory and defeat. The team wishes her all the best as she continues with track and field at Oregon State next year.

Sydney had a PR at state with a Long Jump of 18'10.25". This jump placed her 7th and gave her all-state honors. Sydney also Triple Jumped a distance of 37'11". This placed her 10th overall.

Raelyn jumped 19'5.5" besting her 19'4.25" mark from last year. Raelyn placed 4th overall. This is the second year in a row Raelyn has earned all-state honors.

The team is thankful to the graduating seniors and looking forward to having 2 returning All-State athletes.

The team banquet will be this Thursday Night at 6:30 PM in the East Cafeteria.



Girls Lacrosse

Varsity finished regular season with a 15-4 record, ranked #4 in the state, second in conference behind New Trier.

The team honored their 8 seniors at Senior Night vs. Oak Park with a 16-10 victory! On Monday they then faced defending state champ, Hinsdale and were tied 9-9 to close the first half, went up 11-9 to open the half and then could not control the draw and fell 24-14.

The team then closed out conference play with a win over Vernon Hills. The Titans are seeded #1 in their sectional and will face McHenry, Monday May 20, at 6:00 p.m., at Forest View Educational Center in Arlington Heights.

JV Season concluded with a strong showing at the Loyola JV Tournament with a 2-2 record with close losses to New Trier and

Hinsdale. The team then finished their season with a solid win over Vernon Hills!

F/S Season ended with a 8-5 record and a very tough fought loss to Oak Park 5-4. The team shows much promise for the coming years playing tight games against the best teams in the state.

Qualifiers included: Senior Dimitri Manesiotis who broke his own school record in the Shot Put (57-4) to place 2nd overall. Senior Michael Zimmermann who placed 2nd in the High Jump (6-3). Junior Will Houser (1:57.28) and Senior Charlie Schultz (1:57.79) who dominated the 800 Meter Run placing 1st and 2nd and Freshman Nathan Shapiro who placed 2nd in the 300 Meter Hurdles (40.23). Congratulations!

Other place winners at Sectionals were: Senior Sen Francis (3rd in the Triple jump), Freshman Noah Shapiro (4th in the 400 Meter Dash),

Sophomore Ryan Faut (4th in the Discus) and Nathan Shapiro (5th in the Long Jump).

Best of luck at State next weekend!

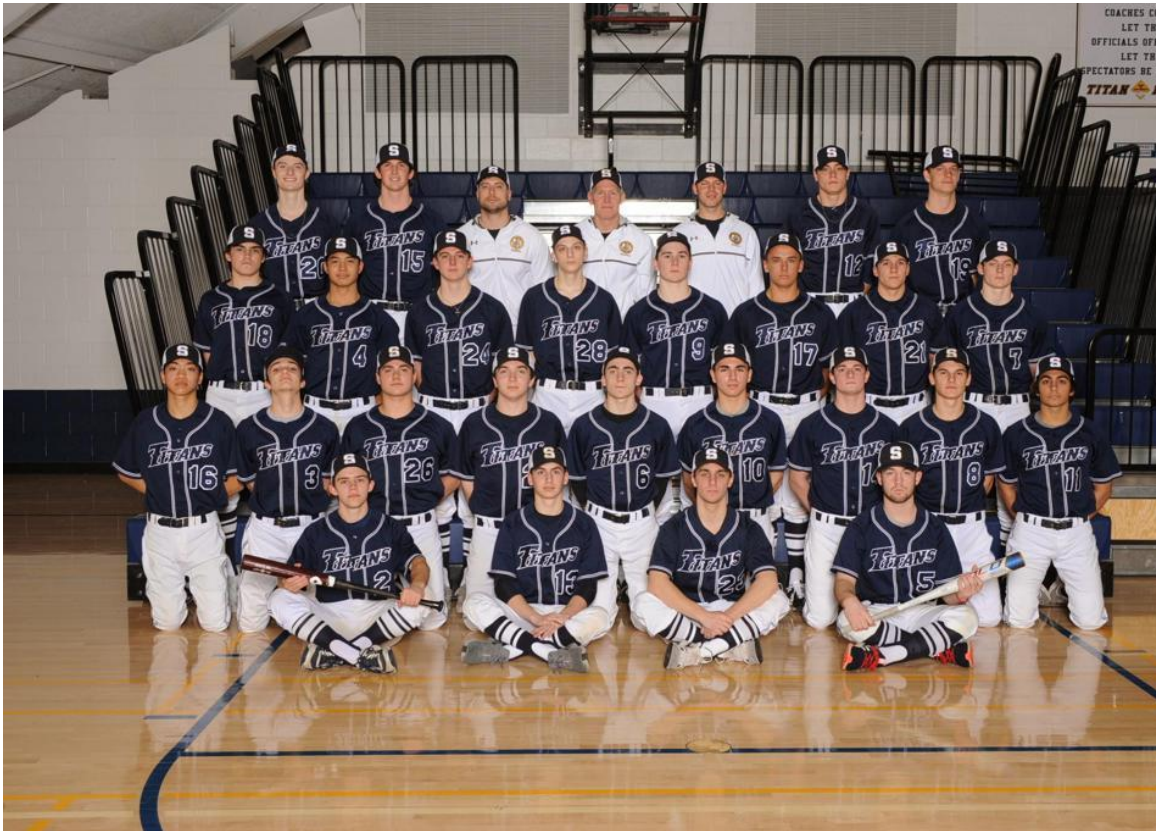


Titans Helping Titans

Only three games this week, but the biggest game proved to be a 5-3 win against Maine South on Monday. That win, coupled with a New Trier loss, gave the Titans the CSL South title. A strong game on the mound helped the team as Danny Pauletto (jr) and Joseph Shapiro (jr) combined to throw a complete game, only giving up 2 earned runs and striking out 10 Maine South batters in the process. The offense was carried by George Korompilas (so) who went 2-4 with 1 run scored and 1 RBI. Danny Hawes also went 2-2 with 1 RBI.

On Wednesday, GBS lost a tight game against the same Maine South team by a score of 2-1. Ryan O'Hara, Kevin Redfern, and Declan Hood

combined to pitch a strong game, only allowing 1 earned run. Unfortunately, the offense was a little stagnant getting just 5 hits total and scoring only 1 run.

The Titans finished out the week with a wild 10-8 loss to Lake Forest. The offensive support was provided by a surging George Korompilas (so) who went 4-4 with a HR and 3 RBI's. Jack Durchin chipped in going 2-2 with an RBI and Luke Smith also had 2 RBI's. On the mound, the Titans used a combination of 4 pitchers who only gave up 1 earned run, but a difficult defensive day was too much to overcome for the Titans.

The team has a big week ahead! Monday is the last regular season game at home against Nazareth. With a win, the Titans will reach the 20 win mark for the regular season.

Raise Money for Titan Athletes, Sign Up for the 2019 Hero Hustle 10K/5K

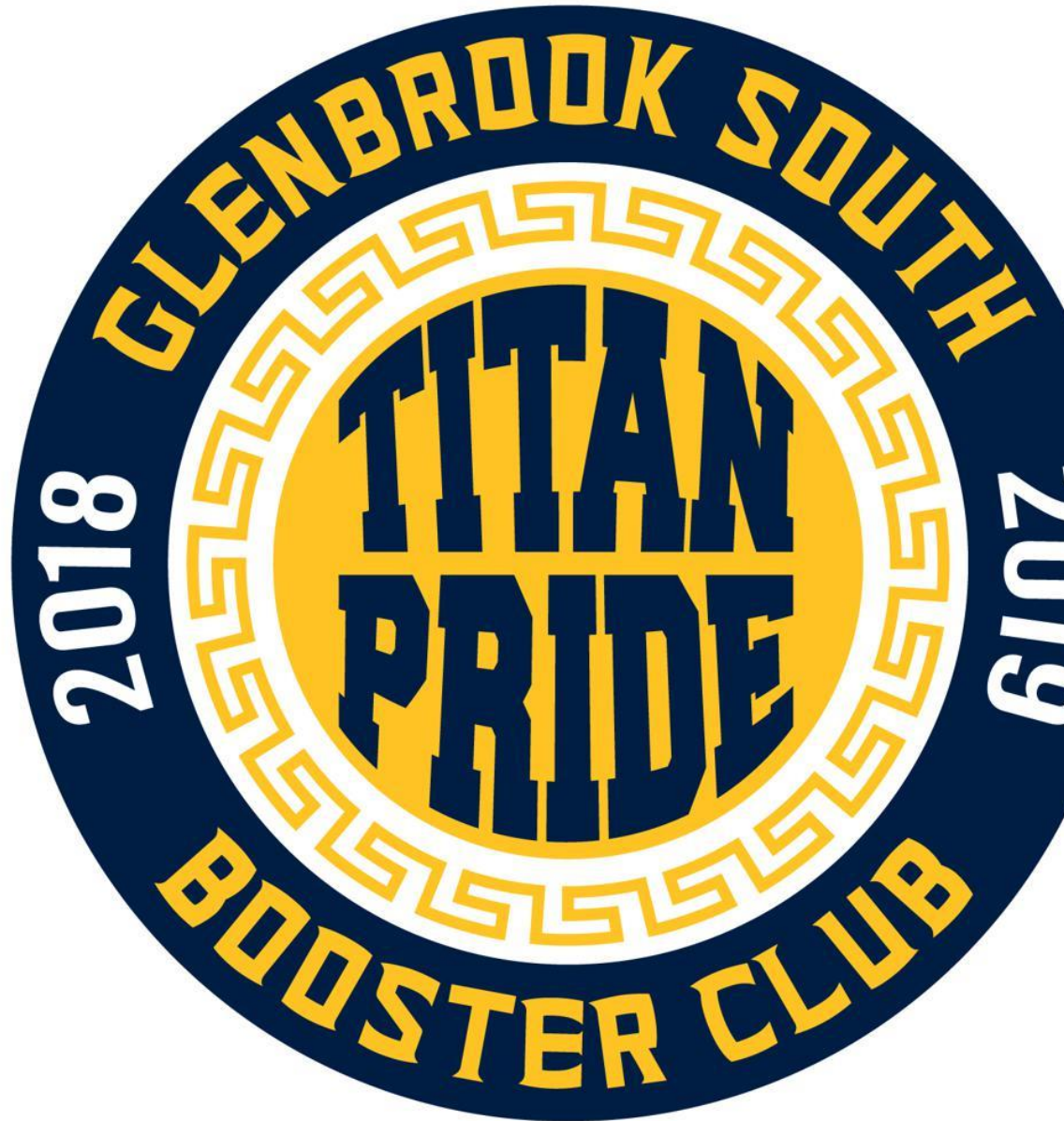

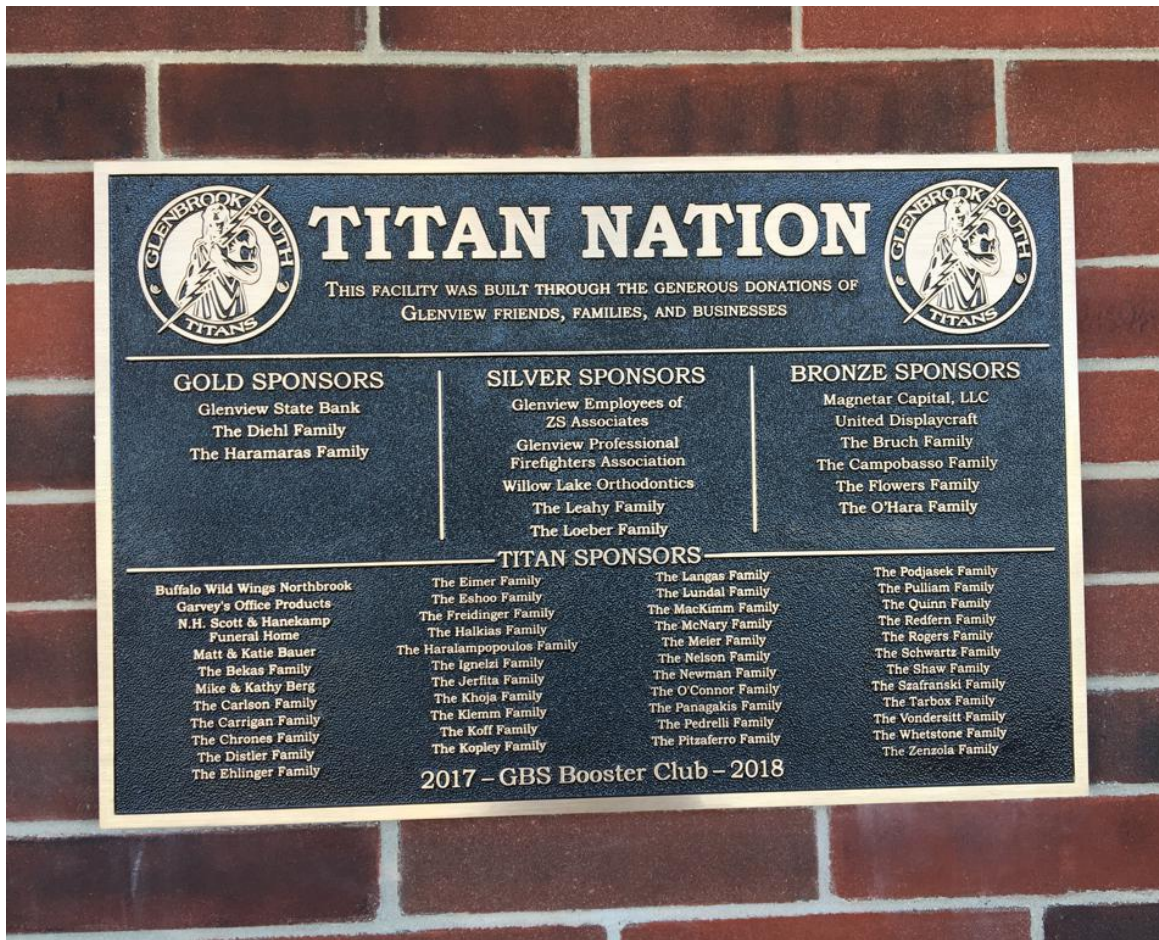
