



## Rotary Club of Aspen's DUCKY DERBY 2.0

### A Ball Race at Aspen Highlands

### Saturday, August 14

- Instead of a duck race, it's a ball roll down the Thunderbowl ski run at Aspen Highlands. It's a "duck-out-of-water" race with yellow balls rolling down Aspen Highlands Thunderbowl instead of rubber ducks floating down the Roaring Fork River!
- 200 balls will be released to bounce down Thunderbowl to be trapped at the bottom.
- 200 balls create about 20,000 different combination of numbers. All chances are pre-assigned a number. The first two ball numbers which finish will link to a winning number. The second two balls are linked to the second winner, etc. There will be three winners who will receive \$5,000, \$1000 and \$500.
- A suggested donation of \$10 per ball gets you in the race. The number on your donation will be assigned to whatever number of chances you purchased.
- This is a family-friendly event which includes live music, youth group games and activities, silent auction, and food/drink from the Highlands Alehouse.
- Your donation supports community non-profits, international service projects and high school scholarships in Basalt and Aspen. Since 1992, the Aspen Rotary has raised more than \$4 million.
- This new event is due to COVID restrictions against large crowds at the time Rotary had to make a decision about a traditional Ducky Derby race.
