

2026 Black Hills Rapids Indoor/WRAS Adult Division tournament Rules

Player requirements:

1. Must be a validated USASA registrant
2. Must sign Tournament Roster recognized by the League
3. All divisions, Men Open and Coed age eligibility must be met by the start of tournament play
 - Open – age requirements for both genders will be 18 and older
 - Co-ed – age requirements Men 30 and older/Women 18 and older
5. No jewelry
6. Jerseys or shirts MUST have a unique number (this is EVERY player, except for full-time keepers) and match the number indicated on the roster, NO sharing of jerseys. CANNOT USE TAPE TO NUMBER JERSEYS.
7. Player may play for **ONLY** one team
8. Players must be able to provide eligibility to tournament staff, tournament director, or WRAS league coordinator if requested.

Basic Rules

1. Games will be played 5 v 5 with keepers.
2. Roster size - 8 minimum; 10 maximum sizes.
3. Coed Open will always field 2 women; if a team cannot field 2 females, then the team plays down a man.
4. Overtime – When teams go into overtime in the Co-ed division MUST have at least 1 female on the court throughout the duration of overtime.
5. All teams must check in at least 1 hour prior to their first scheduled game time.
6. Spectators will not be allowed on the bench or bench side.
7. Games are 19 minutes with a 2-minute half time; no overtime in pool games.
8. Overtime in Semi or Final games will be following Black Hills Rapids Tournament Rules
 - Golden Time Overtime
 - One overtime period will be played until a goal is scored. Each team will begin overtime with a full team minus 1(one) player. Unless a red card has been issued, teams would start 4v4.
 - Kick off will be decided by coin toss.
 - If no goal is scored after the first two (2) minutes of overtime, each team will remove one player (3v3).
 - If no goal is scored after four (4) minutes of overtime, another player will be removed (2v2).
 - If no goal is scored after six (6) minutes, the result will go to penalty kicks.
 - Penalty Kick Shootout
 - Each team will select three (3) eligible players to shoot, and a goalkeeper to defend. Names must be given to the referee.
 - If still tied after three (3) kicks, team will alternate shooters using remaining eligible players on sudden death basis.
 - Any eligible player may switch places with the goalkeeper.
 - Players will remain on opposite half of the pitch,
9. Substitutions are on the fly, you must enter and leave from the center line
 - Your team kick-in.
 - Goal Kick.
 - Injury.
 - Caution is given.
 - After a goal.
 - Substitutions are unlimited.

10. Official time kept by tournament staff.

11. The goalkeeper may throw the ball over half, but the ball must touch the floor or a player outside of the opponent's penalty area. If the ball enters the opposing team's goal area without touching the floor or a player, an IFK will be awarded to the opposing team.

12. Home team is designated to change if colors conflict.

13. Yellow Card Penalty

- Any player that accumulates 3 yellow cards will be suspended for 1 game.

14. Any player who receives a red card will incur a \$100.00 fee and is required to sit out their next scheduled game

15. As the definition of "Abuse and Assault" in the USSF is adopted by WRAS and will be followed

16. In case of emergency, modifications to the event will be made by the tournament director and/or staff.

Point System:

Win = 3 points

1. Tie = 1 point

2. Loss = 0 points

3. Red Card = -1 point (deduct a point)

4. Forfeit = Forfeiting team -1 point and score 0 – 3 non-forfeiting team 3 points and score 3-0

Tie Breakers:

1. Head-to-Head **

2. Goal Differential up to 3

3. Fewest Goals scored Against

4. Goal Scored

**If still tied, the above sequence is followed beginning with the 2nd tiebreaker.

FIFA RULES – All FIFA rules are in effect except where noted above. All decisions are final.

Play with positive and safe sportsmanship, play fair, and have fun.
