

Coaches, Student-Athletes, Parents, and Guardians,

Please see the following information as it relates to Athletics & Activities during our school closure. In accordance with [Governor Evers' Executive Order](#), school facilities are closed for all school-related activities, including extracurricular activities. This closure is in effect until further notice.

The WIAA has provided further clarification as it relates to extracurricular participation limitations. During the closure, coaches MAY NOT assemble with teams or student-athletes. Students may gather on their own to conduct volunteer workouts if they choose. However, any volunteer activities MAY NOT involve school coaches, and MAY NOT be conducted at a school facility.

In summary:

- Schools/coaches MAY NOT bring students together during the state mandated school closure for the purpose of extracurricular or athletic purposes. This includes, but is not limited to: training, practices, scrimmages, and contests.
- Students MAY NOT use district facilities per the state mandate.
- Coaches may provide students with individual workouts virtually, but schools/coaches MAY NOT encourage their team to assemble for group practice and training.

At this point we have not received any further information regarding the WIAA spring sports season and will update families as we receive it.
