Hi Derek,

I (somewhat) willingly accept the nomination for the VP Girls slot on the state board. Heidi says I need to send you a short bio. If this isn't what you had in mind, let me know:

I grew up playing hockey in Maine -- oldest in a family of six. My only brother was the youngest of us six, and he also played. But the four sisters in between us were given no opportunity for the organized sport, despite playing regularly on our pond. My primary reason for seeking a position on the state board is to ensure that girls who love the game can find a place to play it.

My firstborn started hockey when she was 5, just after we moved to Utah. Now 17, she has played Lady Lightning or Lady Grizzlies every year since she was 9. Her younger sister started at age 3 and has also played for both teams. I have coached for both organizations (12U/14U/19U), but did not coach (girls) this season and do not plan to in the future. Next year, as this year, I will have one daughter playing for Lady Grizz 19U and one playing Lady Grizz 14U, but my commitment to girls hockey extends to all ages and levels.

Beyond girls hockey, I coached house for years at Steiner, and I've coached for the Lightning and Jr. Grizzlies programs, as well as for the Storm independent high school team. Both of my daughters play co-ed hockey too -- this year for the PC Ice Miners and Golden Eagles -- as does my son. I'm not devoted to any organization or level of play, I'm devoted to all kids finding a hockey team on which they can thrive.
