



## Worldwide Soccer, LLC – Blarney Blast 3v3 2021

Please read and process all information below for tournament protocols.

1. We are strongly recommending only one parent per player attends each game and must wear a mask at all times. It is in the best interest of grandparents & siblings to remain home. **ALL SPECTATORS MUST WEAR A MASK.**
2. When approaching tournament or medical staff, please wear a mask.
3. Parents and Players are required to bring their own hand sanitizer, towels & water bottles. **(Mandatory)**
4. Teams and their spectators will sit on the same side of the field. The opposing team will be on the opposite side of the field.
5. Players and parents are to ensure their player is healthy by checking temperatures before activities. Do not attend games if exhibiting any symptoms of Covid-19 including fever, cough, difficulty breathing, or others identified by CDC.
6. Players, when not on the field, please keep 6 feet from others and all equipment and wear a mask. Please do not share any water or equipment with others.
7. There will be vendors at the tournament selling products. Please make sure you wear a mask when interacting and also practice social distancing.
8. Limit sharing equipment. **PARENTS AND PLAYERS BRING THEIR OWN CHAIRS .**
9. **PLAYERS, COACHES & MANAGERS - Field Arrival & Departure Protocol:**  
Arrival – no earlier than 30 minutes before start of game.  
Departure – Everyone to leave directly after the game finishes, to allow safe arrival of the next teams playing. **No Loitering .**  
No team celebrations after goal scored or at the conclusion of the game by the winning team. **NO HAND SHAKING, HUGS OR HIGH FIVES @ ANY TIME DURING THE GAME .**  
Players coming to and going from the fields will wear a mask. Players on the bench will wear a mask .
10. **Teams are asked to practice social distancing**
  - a. During pregame and warmup

- b. Team talks and water breaks
- c. Half time
- d. End of game

**11. COACHES:**

Ensure safety of own players and send home any that look or exhibit any symptoms.  
Instruct players not to share any equipment and be the only one that handles all equipment such as cones etc.  
Wear a face mask where possible around players when you cannot be 6 feet apart.  
Have hand sanitizer with you for use during games or in stoppages in games.

**12. PARENTS – Field Arrival & Departure Protocol:**

Arrival – no earlier than 10 minutes before game starts. WAIT UNTIL THE PREVIOUS SIDELINE HAS CLEARED BEFORE ARRIVING

Departure – Everyone to leave directly after the game finishes, to allow safe arrival of the next teams playing. **No Loitering** . NO AFTER GAME DISCUSSIONS AT THE FIELDS.

- 13.** Clean bench areas and remove all trash after your game. We recommend the next team coming in disinfects the bench area prior to using them. Or have players bring own chairs.
- 14.** No shared water or water stations
- 15.** After each game, coaches should make sure they have each other's contact information in case there is a need to inform a team you have played of a potential COVID situation.
- 16.** Coaches and/or managers should call the opposition coach, manager, and tournament director if they learn that any parent, coach or player was sick during the game. We would request that you report any situation in which a player, coach or parent test positive for COVID-19 after the game to the tournament director.
