SEASON INFORMATION

Training, Team Practices, and Game Schedule

Fall Practice Schedules for the top 16u-18u Scout Teams are limited due to the busy fall season and other commitments young players will have: football, college visits, camps, etc. Players will have facility access throughout the competitive season (August 1st - October 1st).

There will also be approximately 6-8 Team Practices scheduled throughout the 8 weeks of the Fall Season. Additionally, there will be some scheduled time for players to come in and coaching staff with throw Batting Practice and hit Ground Balls.

Below is a mock schedule for a typical tournament week. Non-Tournament Weeks will simply have more facility access on Friday and Weekends.

Once you have officially registered for the fall season - you will be eligible to receive a formal roster invite.


