The information below will help everyone to have a good experience at our annual 4 v 4 tournament. Please read all the information and let me know if you have any questions.

1. Please check-in 30 minutes before your scheduled first game. Every team is required to have the waiver form turned in at the check-in.

2. Players don't need to be at the check-in. Only the team coach or the manager is required to check the team in. **Some age groups have been combined.**
3. Home team is listed first on the schedule. The home team has to provide the game ball, must change uniform in case of a color conflict. Home team will get to choose the team bench side and the side to defend. Home team will also get the 1st half kickoff.
4. We strongly recommend to print the copy of the new 4 v 4 rules (link below) and bring with you. Fields map will be posted by Friday evening. The field numbers are written inside of each goal.
Note, the goals are placed outside of playing field.
5. Over flow parking is available at the school parking lot just past the park.
Cars will be ticketed if parked on Stonebridge parkway on the bicycle path. Carpooling is recommended.
6. Should for any reasons the schedule does get revised between now and the tournament date, we suggest to please double check your team schedule the night before the tournament.
7. After the conclusion of your game, please verify the score with the referee. Once the referee reports the score to the score keeper, that score is final.
Scores get updated after the games once it is reported by the referee. We will post the score on the fence next to the check-in tent.
8. Please keep in mind the two finalist teams will be given awards. Each player on both teams will receive an individual award. Both finalist should report to the check-in area for the award ceremony. We will also be going around during the day to look for the best team costume. Once identified, the players for that team will each be awarded a prize.
9. Lastly, we appreciate if you ask the players and parents on your team to help us to keep our parks clean. There are trash cans all around the fields for their convenient.
